

**MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 28, 2025
REGULAR MEETING OF
THE COUNCIL ON JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS**

The Council on Judicial Complaints convened a Regular Meeting on August 28, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., in the Oklahoma Bar Center at 1901 North Lincoln Blvd, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Notice of the August 28, 2025 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints was filed with the Secretary of State on December 5, 2024. The meeting's agenda was posted in the front entryway of the Oklahoma Bar Center and on the Council on Judicial Complaints website on or before August 27, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Chairman Rick Rose, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, Member Zack Taylor, General Counsel John Bunting, and Director Taylor Henderson were present in-person at the above-described location at 9:00 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Rose at 9:10 a.m. Tres Savage was in attendance as a member of the public.

Director Henderson presented the minutes for the June 19, 2025 Special Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved that the minutes of the June 19, 2025 Special Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints be approved as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the Administrative Director's FY 2025 Claims and Expenditures Report and associated 6-Digit Detail Expenditure Report inclusive of receipts through August 22, 2025. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the claims and expenditure report as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson reported that following the final accounting for FY 25 expenditures, \$39,531.24 remained in FY 25 appropriated funds (Class 19301). Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to carryover the remaining FY 25 appropriated funds to FY 26. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the Administrative Director's FY 2026 Claims and Expenditures Report and associated 6-Digit Detail Expenditure Report inclusive of receipts through August 22, 2025. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the claims and expenditure report as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the FY 2025 fee collection report inclusive of receipts through the month of June 2025. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the fee collection report as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson reported three upcoming judicial education events were scheduled to include the National Center for State Courts Center for Judicial Ethics National College on Judicial Conduct and Ethics in Louisville, Kentucky October 15-17, 2025; a presentation regarding demeanor and behavior at the Oklahoma Municipal League Annual Conference September 10, 2025 in Oklahoma City; and a presentation at OCU Law October 8, 2025. No action was taken.

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to enter into Executive Session as authorized by Title 25 O.S.Supp.2022, § 307(B)(4) and 307(B)(7) for the purpose of discussing *Linh Tran Stephens v. State of OK*, et al. (25-CV-322-SHE-JFJ). Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to reconvene in open session. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose. No action was taken on the information discussed in executive session.

A discussion was had of the upcoming regularly scheduled meetings for September and October 2025. No action was taken.

There was no new business for discussion.
