

**MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 15, 2025
RESCHEDULED REGULAR MEETING OF
THE COUNCIL ON JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS**

The Council on Judicial Complaints convened a Rescheduled Regular Meeting on December 15, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., in the Oklahoma Bar Center at 1901 North Lincoln Blvd, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Notice of the November 2025 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints was filed with the Oklahoma Secretary of State on December 5, 2024. Notice that the November 2025 Meeting would be rescheduled to December 15, 2025, was filed with the Secretary of State on November 18, 2025. The meeting's agenda was posted in the front entryway of the Oklahoma Bar Center on December 11, 2025, at 11:35 a.m. and on the Council on Judicial Complaints website on December 11, 2025, at 11:44 a.m. Chairman Rick Rose, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, Member Zack Taylor, General Counsel John Bunting, and Director Taylor Henderson were present in-person at the above-described location at 9:00 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Rose at 9:07 a.m. Lt. Alan Beaty of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol was in attendance. No additional members of the public were in attendance.

Director Henderson presented the minutes for the September 25, 2025 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved that the minutes of the September 25, 2025 Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints be approved as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Chairman Rick Rose, Member Zack Taylor, and Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the Administrative Director's FY 2026 Claims and Expenditures Report and associated 6-Digit Detail Expenditure Report inclusive of receipts through December 5, 2025. Member Zack Taylor moved to approve

the claims and expenditure report as presented. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Chairman Rick Rose, Member Zack Taylor, and Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the FY 2026 fee collection report inclusive of receipts through the month of September 2025. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the fee collection report as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Chairman Rick Rose, Member Zack Taylor, and Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm.

Director Henderson reported on the attendance of staff, council members, and judicial officers at the National Center for State Courts Judicial Ethics College in October 2025 as part of the Council's judicial education programming. No action was taken.

There were no new or upcoming judicial education expenditures or activities to report. No action was taken.

Director Henderson reported that the spring 2026 board meeting of the Association of Judicial Disciplinary Counsel will be held in Oklahoma City. No action was taken.

The agenda item relative to scanning services from OMES was passed for future discussion. No discussion was had and no action was taken.

Director Henderson presented the Oklahoma State Auditor & Inspector's audit report of the Council on Judicial Complaints for the period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025. The Council specifically discussed that the State Auditor reported no findings were identified as a result of the procedures performed. No action was taken.


There were no changes to the schedule of the January 2026 or February 2026 regular meetings.

Director Henderson advised that there was new business for discussion. On December 12, 2025, Director Henderson learned that staff, council members, and the council were named in litigation that required response from the Council on Judicial Complaints. Because the agenda for the December 15, 2025 Meeting had already been posted to the website and front door of the Oklahoma Bar Association, the agenda could not be updated to include an executive session to discuss the litigation, and the Council could not enter into an executive session. After advising the Council members of the litigation in open session, Director Henderson presented a Contract for Professional Services to be entered between the Council on Judicial Complaints and Robert McCampbell, Esq., for the purpose of representing the Council, staff, and members in the litigation. Director Henderson further advised the contract would require approval from the Oklahoma Attorney General pursuant to 74 O.S. § 20(i). Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the Contract for Professional Services, as presented, and submit to the Oklahoma Attorney General for approval in conformity with 74 O.S. § 20i. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Chairman Rick Rose, Member Zack Taylor, and Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm.

Chairman Rick Rose moved to adjourn the public meeting to conduct, discuss, or deliberate any matter relating to a complaint received or initiated by the Council on Judicial Complaints. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Chairman Rick Rose, Member Zack Taylor, and Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm.
