

**MINUTES OF THE MAY 14, 2026
REGULAR MEETING OF
THE COUNCIL ON JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS**

The Council on Judicial Complaints convened a Rescheduled Regular Meeting on May 14, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in the Oklahoma Bar Center at 1901 North Lincoln, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Notice that the Regularly Scheduled April Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints would be rescheduled to May 14, 2026, was filed with the Secretary of State on April 13, 2026. The meeting's agenda was posted in the front entryway of the Oklahoma Bar Center and on the Council on Judicial Complaints website on or before May 13, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Chairman Rick Rose, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, Member Zack Taylor, General Counsel John Bunting, and Director Taylor Henderson were present in-person at the above-described location at 9:00 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Rose at 9:15 a.m. No members of the public were in attendance.

Director Henderson presented the minutes for the February 26, 2026 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved that the minutes of the February 2026 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints be approved as presented. Chairman Rick Rose seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm and Chairman Rick Rose. Member Zack Taylor abstained from the vote.

Director Henderson presented the minutes for the March 26, 2026 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved that the minutes of the March 2026 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints be approved as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative

votes of Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm and Member Zack Taylor. Chairman Rick Rose abstained from the vote.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the Administrative Director's FY 2026 Claims and Expenditures Report and associated 6-Digit Detail Expenditure Report inclusive of receipts through May 8, 2026. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the reports as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the FY 2026 fee collection report inclusive of receipts through the month of March 2026. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the fee collection report as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Henderson provided an update on recent judicial education events. There were no proposed expenditures related to judicial education for discussion. No action was taken.

Director Henderson presented the ongoing contracts, subscriptions, and recurring expenses for FY 2027 as set forth in agenda items 3(f)(1)-3(f)(6). Member Zack Taylor moved to approve the FY 2027 contracts, subscriptions, and recurring expenses as presented. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented the proposed FY27 Budget Work Program. A discussion was had explaining the differences between the FY26 BWP and proposed FY27 BWP. Further discussion included a proposed decrease to the line item for the 2026 COJC Judicial

College within the Judicial Education (003) budget category from \$50,000 to \$40,000. Angela Ailles Bahm moved to amend the proposed budget work program as discussed for a total budget of \$787,300 for FY 27. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson sought approval to encumber expenditures for Council staff to attend the 2026 Association of Judicial Disciplinary Counsel Annual Meeting and Conference July 21 – 24, 2026, in Chicago, Illinois. Following discussion, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the travel and expenditures in an amount in conformity with the Oklahoma State Travel Reimbursement Act for all Council staff. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to enter into Executive Session as authorized by Title 25 O.S. Supp. 2025, § 307(B)(4) for the purpose of discussing *In re the Petition for Grand Jury filed by Parents for Payne County*, Case no. GJ-2025-2 (Payne Co.) and *In re the Petition for Grand Jury filed by Parents for Payne County*, Case No. GJ-2026-1 (Payne Co.). Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose. An Executive Session was had.

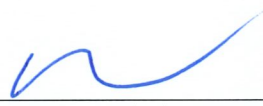

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to adjourn the public meeting to conduct, discuss, or deliberate any matter relating to a complaint received or initiated by the Council on Judicial Complaints. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles-Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

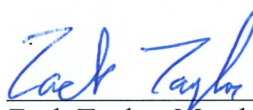
