

MINUTES OF THE JUNE 25, 2026 REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL ON JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

The Council on Judicial Complaints convened a Regular Meeting on June 25, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in the Oklahoma Bar Center at 1901 North Lincoln, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Notice that the Regularly Scheduled June Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints would was filed with the Secretary of State on November 24, 2025. The meeting's agenda was posted in the front entryway of the Oklahoma Bar Center and on the Council on Judicial Complaints website on or before June 24, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Chairman Rick Rose, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, Member Zack Taylor, General Counsel John Bunting, Attorney Patricia Parrish, and Director Taylor Henderson were present in-person at the above-described location at 9:00 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Rose at 9:08 a.m. No members of the public were in attendance.

Director Henderson presented the minutes for the May 14, 2026 Rescheduled Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved that the minutes of the May 2026 Regular Meeting of the Council on Judicial Complaints be approved as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the Administrative Director's FY 2026 Claims and Expenditures Report and associated 6-Digit Detail Expenditure Report inclusive of receipts through June 19, 2026. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the reports as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried

with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Taylor Henderson presented and the Council considered the FY 2026 fee collection report inclusive of receipts through the month of April 2026. Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to approve the fee collection report as presented. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Director Henderson provided an update on recent judicial education events. There were no proposed expenditures related to judicial education for discussion. No action was taken.

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to enter into Executive Session as authorized by Title 25 O.S.Supp.2022, §§ 307(B)(1) and (B)(4) for the purpose of discussing:

- (a) the employment and salary of the Executive Director, Principal Assistant, and General Counsel of the Council on Judicial Complaints;
- (b) *In re the Petition for Grand Jury filed by Parents for Payne County*, Case no. GJ-2025-2 (Payne Co.) and *In re the Petition for Grand Jury filed by Parents for Payne County*, Case No. GJ-2026-1 (Payne Co.); and
- (c) *Scott Loftis v. Richard Rose et al.*, Case No. CIV-26-1172-D (WDOK)

Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

An Executive Session was had.

At 10:10 a.m., Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to reconvene in open session to vote on matters considered in executive session. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion.

The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Following the discussion in Executive Session, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles moved to increase the salary of the Executive Director to \$183,750 beginning July 1, 2026. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Following the discussion in Executive Session, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to increase the salary of the General Counsel to \$157,500 beginning July 1, 2026. Vice Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Following the discussion in Executive Session, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to increase the salary of the Principal Assistant to \$89,250 beginning July 1, 2026. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Discussion regarding subparts (b) and (c) was had in executive session; no action was taken.

Following a discussion of the officers of the Council on Judicial Complaints for FY 27, Angela Ailles Bahm nominated Rick Rose to continue to serve as Chairman, Zack Taylor to continue to serve as Member, and herself to continue to serve as Vice Chairwoman. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with the affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.

Following a discussion of upcoming regularly scheduled meetings, Chairman Rick Rose noted that the July 2026 Regularly Scheduled meeting was previously cancelled and the August 2026 meeting remains scheduled to occur. Discussion was had; no action was taken.

There was no new business for discussion.

Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles Bahm moved to adjourn the public meeting to conduct, discuss, or deliberate any matter relating to a complaint received or initiated by the Council on Judicial Complaints. Member Zack Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried with affirmative votes of Member Zack Taylor, Vice Chairwoman Angela Ailles-Bahm, and Chairman Rick Rose.
