**SUMMARY:**

The proposed rule amendments update the Department of Labor's physical address as well as the names and addresses of several national code organizations. The circumstances which created the need for the amendments are that the Department of Labor moved into a different building with a different address as did several national code organizations, one of which changed its name. The intended effect of the proposed amendments is to ensure accurate address information is contained in the rules.
