This is to notify you that the above company or owner is operating in violation of Oklahoma Amusement Ride Safety Act, 40 O.S. §§460 - 473 and Oklahoma Administrative Code 380:55.

The above-named company or owner has not legally registered with the Oklahoma Department of Labor, Safety Standards Division.

The above-named ride is not legally registered with the Oklahoma Department of Labor, Safety Standards Division.

The above-named company or owner or ride has not been inspected by an Oklahoma Department of Labor Amusement Ride Inspector, or, beginning November 9, 2017, a qualified amusement ride inspector employed by an insurance company. Oklahoma Amusement ride Safety Act 40 O.S. §462.

The above-named company and or ride has failed to meet requisite safety requirements of the Oklahoma Amusement Ride Safety Act 40 O.S. §460-473 and Oklahoma Administrative Code 380:55, in particular the requirements of [CITE AUTHORITY] _____

The above named company or owner, prior to operating an amusement ride, failed to provide the Oklahoma Department of Labor with proof of a valid liability insurance policy of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) as required by 40 O.S. §460-473

The above-named company or owner has operated an amusement ride without having a current Certificate of Operation on file with the Oklahoma Department of Labor. Oklahoma Amusement Ride Safety Act 40 O.S. §462.

The above named company or owner and or ride has operated with overdue inspection fees in violation of 40 O.S. §463 and Oklahoma Administrative Code 380:55-5-4. [No ride of an owner who has a fee account more than (30) days past due shall be inspected or permitted to operate until the balance of the fee account is paid in full and received by the Oklahoma Department of Labor.]

The above named ride does not have a current valid inspection decal displayed. [Non-compliance is not, in itself, a violation of Oklahoma statute if the company or owner can produce other proof of current valid inspection.]

Operation of an unregistered amusement ride within the State of Oklahoma is a misdemeanor punishable by a civil fine up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or up to one (1) year in the county jail, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day of violation shall constitute separate offense. Oklahoma Amusement Ride Safety Act , 40 O.S. §469. An ADDITIONAL administrative fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per violation, per day, may also be assessed, in addition to civil fine. Oklahoma Administrative Code 380:55-1-3(a).
