Library patrons are invited to read any of the books on the list to earn their Zoo vouchers.

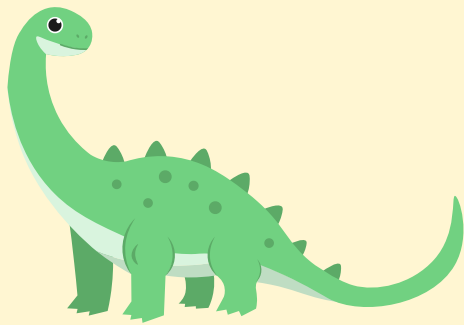
