- 7. Discussion and possible action regarding the 2025 rulemaking process, in consultation with legal counsel, including, but not limited to, a review of public comments received and record of public hearing, and possible revision and adoption to the final rule changes as follows:
 - OAC 420:1-1-4, to change the language to be consistent with the Oklahoma Open Records Act;
 - OAC 420:10-1-3, correct the scrivener error re the definition of Employee to be the definition of Employer;
 - OAC 420:10-1-5, to increase the Class 7 permit fee from \$50.00 to \$85.00;
 - OAC 420:10-1-8, to modify the passing grade for the Class 1 and Class 10 examinations from 80% to 75%, and modify the question composition for Class 1 and Class 10 examinations;
 - a. Review and consideration of Sam Sparks' public comment
 - b. Review and consideration of the Oklahoma Propane Gas Association public comment
 - OAC 420:10-1-9, to modify and clarify the process for requesting to operate without a Class 10 permit upon termination death, or other relief of duty of a Class 10 manager;
 - OAC 420:10-1-13, to modify and clarify the administrative process of requesting Class 10 coverage at two locations;

- OAC 420:10-1-14, to correct erroneous grammatical error in subsection (2)(A) and updated the language in subsection (2)(D) to be consistent with the language in 420:10-1-5(b)(9).
 - a. Review and consideration of: Change 420:10-1-14(b)(13)(C) from "For all size bulk storage containers, the name of the fee simple owners, if other than the consumer, shall be conspicuously shown on the container" to "All registered permit holders shall conspicuously mark any bulk size storage containers it owns so that the owner of any given container can be easily identified."
- 8. Discussion and possible action regarding status update on submission of previously approved proposed statute amendments to the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Act and to submit the following as an additional submission proposed statute amendment:
 - 52 O.S. § 420.12 Investigation of Fires Report to Liquefied Petroleum Gas Administration Record of Fires The Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board shall have the right to conduct thorough investigations of Liquefied Petroleum Gas accidents or fires in this State. In case of an accident or fire at any location where there is a liquefied petroleum gas system or equipment, or in the case of any accident or fire where a liquefied petroleum gas system or equipment is or may be involved, the Oklahoma State Fire Marshal, the sheriff of the county, and the chief of the fire department or the mayor if no fire department exists, shall notify the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Administrator of said accident or fire immediately at the time they become aware of same. In no event shall this notification be forwarded later than (1) one business day after knowledge of the accident or fire is obtained, in order to enable an investigation to be made by the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Administration before the site has been disturbed.
- 9. Discussion and possible action regarding Ferrellgas' report of compliance with the Board's previous directive issued by letter dated October 30, 2024. Ferrellgas' legal counsel requested to make a statement regarding compliance.
- 10. Ferrellgas's report of the new location and discussion and possible action regarding Ferrellgas Class X coverage at the new location. Ferrellgas' legal counsel requested to speak to the Board regarding Class X coverage at their new location.
