

## Class VIII (8) Un-odorized LPG Permit Application

Permits the holder to obtain, use and store un-odorized LP Gas at their facility.

Applicant must submit detailed plans describing use and location of cylinder storage, and all LP Gas plumbing in said facility must be submitted in writing and approved for any facility using un-odorized LP Gas in any manner. Plans must be submitted to the LP Gas Administration Office along with the proper fee, and an on-site inspection must be performed by a Safety Code Enforcement Officer prior to final approval and before the introduction of LP Gas into the system.
