

PROTECTION OF NATURAL RESOURCES and OTHER PERMIT REQUIREMENTS Instruction Sheet for Section 3

O.S. Title 45 Section 724

- I. Each application for a new operation shall contain, where applicable, a list of all other licenses and permits needed by the applicant to conduct the proposed mining operation. This list shall identify each license and permit by:
- 1. Type of permit or license;
- 2. Name and address of issuing authority;
- 3. Identification number or a copy of the application for permits or licenses or, if issued, a copy of the permit or license; and
- 4. If a decision has been made, the date of approval or disapproval by each issuing authority.

An existing operation which does not have on file a list of the applicable licenses or permits with the Department on the date of enactment of this act shall not be out of compliance with the provisions of this section. Any renewal of an existing permit or expansion or amendment to an existing operation upon time of application shall submit a copy of all approved licenses and permits issued by other agencies or jurisdictions.

Identifications of all permits and licenses shall include local government agencies with jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the proposed mining operation including, but not limited to, planning agencies, water and sewer authorities; and all state and federal government agencies with authority to issue permits and licenses applicable to the proposed mining operation, including all state environmental agencies, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, U.S. Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service district office, and federal fish and wildlife agencies.

- A. (REVISION): If the application that has been submitted is considered an amendment to the existing permit on file with the Department, please submit copies of all the permits issued for your operation.
- B. (NEW APPLICATION) In response to Section 3 of the non-coal permit application submitted, if your operation indicates the following:
 - Crushing Material
 - > Washing Material or recycling processed water
 - Will involve dewatering the mine or discharging fresh or waste water
 - Fall within the jurisdictional requirement of the storm water regulations
 - > Operate within the boundaries of a river of stream

Based on your response, please provide the Department with evidence of your communications with the appropriate agency or board. This shall include either a notification from the specific regulatory body, a copy of the correspondence that was sent by you to the regulatory body, a copy of the application that has been filed with the regulatory body or a clearance letter from the regulatory body.

Please be advised the permitting process may not proceed further until this issue is addressed.
