Preventing Fire Hazards

Fires are dangerous and all mining operations should take special precautions year round to make sure fires are not carelessly ignited.

Section 910-B3

Areas surrounding flammable-liquid storage tanks and electric substations and transformers shall be kept free from dry grass, weeds, underbrush and other combustible materials for at least (25) feet in all directions.

Any unplanned fire not distinguished with-in 30 minutes of discovery must be reported to MSHA with-in 15 minutes!

Section 917-A7

Areas surrounding magazines not less than twenty-five (25) feet in all directions shall be kept free of rubbish and other combustibles.

Section 910-B15

Each mine shall have available, or be provided with, appropriate types of fire-fighting equipment adequate for the size of the mine.

Fire prevention

- Good maintenance of electrical and mobile equipment
- Good housekeeping
- Proper storage and clean up of combustible and flammable liquids
- Good communications between management, labor, state and federal agencies
- Basically "all fires" in the mining industry can be avoided
