Expedited licensure for active duty military and active duty spouse:

To continue licensure without delay, effective November 1, 2019, every active duty military personnel and their spouse who is licensed or certified as a Licensed Practical Nurse, Registered Nurse or an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse, upon receiving notice or orders for military transfer or honorable discharge to this state, **may in advance of actual transfer or honorable discharge** submit an application for endorsement of currently held valid license or certification from another state or territory of the United States.

- The application fee for the first period of licensure issuance is waived.
- Once application is made, the Board shall issue the requested license within 30 days, provided the
 license or certification from the other state is found to be in good standing and reasonable
 equivalent to the licensure requirements in Oklahoma.
- Applications include military questions.
- If you are active military or an active military spouse, you are required to submit a copy of the *United States Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card* and a copy of the military member's *Permanent Change of Station (PCS)* orders.
