INDICTMENT

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

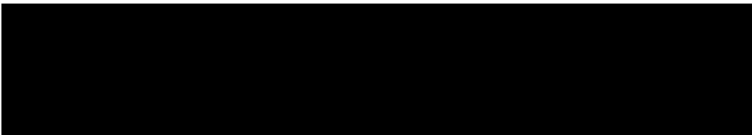
By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from December 16, 2024, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multi-County Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and woman, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ 21 O.S. §1451, a FELONY (Df) 0-5,5K

On or about and between February 22, 2022 and July 21, 2025 the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT** was feloniously committed in Cleveland County, Oklahoma, by **DONALD CHRISTOPHER AMASON**, who willfully and unlawfully appropriated money in excess of two-thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) but less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), from his campaign fund, said money having been legally obtained, and entrusted to the defendant for a specific purpose, use, or disposition, by transferring campaign funds held in a specific campaign account to his personal account in violation of ethical rules governing use of campaign funds by a candidate for an elected office and contrary to the provisions of Section 1451 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

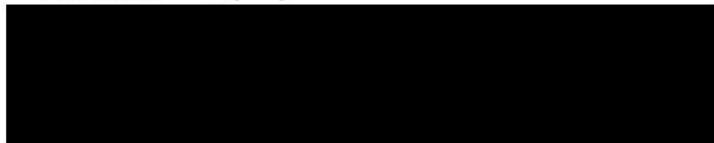

COUNT 2: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ 21 O.S. §1451, a FELONY

On or about and between May 26, 2020, and June 10, 2024, the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT** was feloniously committed in Cleveland County, Oklahoma, by **DONALD CHRISTOPHER AMASON** who willfully and unlawfully appropriated money in excess of two-thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) but less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), from his campaign fund, said money having been legally obtained, and entrusted to the defendant for a specific purpose, use, or disposition, by issuing check payments from his campaign account to himself and others without properly reporting such payments as expenditures in violation of ethical rules governing use of campaign funds by a candidate for an elected office and contrary to the provisions of Section 1451 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

OKLAHOMA MULTICOUNTY GRAND JURY

COUNT 3: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ 21 O.S. §1451, a FELONY

On or about and between August 3, 2020 through October 31, 2024, the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT** was feloniously committed in Cleveland County, Oklahoma, by **DONALD CHRISTOPHER AMASON**, who willfully and unlawfully appropriated money in excess of two-thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) but less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), from his campaign fund, said money having been legally obtained, and entrusted to the defendant for a specific purpose, use, or disposition, by conducting ATM withdrawals from his campaign account and using funds from his campaign account to conduct personal purchases in violation of ethical rules governing use of campaign funds by a candidate for an elected office and contrary to the provisions of Section 1451 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

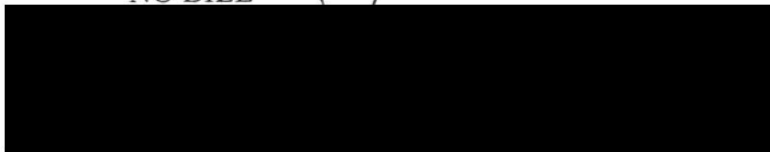

COUNT 4: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ 19 O.S. §641, a FELONY

On or about and between March 18, 2022 through November 29, 2022 the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT** was feloniously committed in Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, by **DONALD CHRISTOPHER AMASON**, who, while serving as the duly elected sheriff for Cleveland County and being charged with the collection, receipt, safekeeping, transfer, or disbursement of public money or any part thereof belonging to Cleveland County, did willfully, unlawfully, and feloniously convert public money to his own use or use of another from Cleveland County, said property being entrusted to DONALD CHRISTOPHER AMASON by virtue of his office, to wit: by directing public funds to pay for his spouse to attend government conferences, contrary to the provisions of Section 641 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
