INDICTMENT

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twenty-Second Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from June 15, 2026, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twenty-Second Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and woman, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: ACCESSORY TO POSSESSION OF CONTRABAND IN A PENAL INSTITUTION, 21 O.S. § 173 and 57 O.S. § 21, a FELONY

On or about March 26, 2025, **ROBIN CORINNE KONRAD** committed the crime of **ACCESSORY TO POSSESSION OF CONTRABAND IN A PENAL INSTITUTION**, a felony, in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma, by actively aiding Tremane Wood after he had committed the felony crime of Possession of Contraband in a Penal Institution, knowing that Tremane Wood had committed the crime of Possession of Contraband in a Penal Institution, and with the intent that Tremane Wood avoid arrest, trial, conviction, or punishment, by Robin Corinne Konrad communicating with Tremane Wood on an unauthorized cellular phone while he was an inmate in the Oklahoma State Penitentiary and directing Tremane Wood to hide the contraband cellular phone so that he would avoid arrest, trial, conviction, or punishment, contrary to the provisions of 21 O.S. § 173 and 57 O.S. § 21 of the Oklahoma statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

On or about or between March 17, 2025, and June 26, 2025, **ROBIN CORINNE KONRAD** committed the crime of **UNLAWFUL COMMUNICATION WITH A CONVICT**, a misdemeanor, in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma, by communicating with Tremane Wood while he was a convict in the Oklahoma State Penitentiary, without authorization by law and/or without the

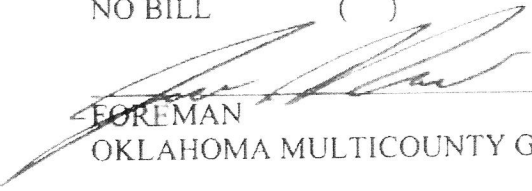
consent of the warden, contrary to the provision of 21 O.S. § 586 of the Oklahoma statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

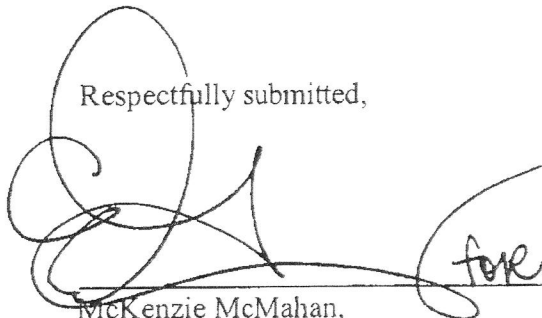

1. Pursuant to 22 O.S.2021, § 385, "[u]pon request of the grand jury's legal advisor, the presiding judge of the grand jury may order the indictment sealed until the defendant is arrested."
2. The undersigned attorney is a legal advisor for the Multi-County Grand Jury.
3. Sealing of the indictment in this case is requested as the Indicted Defendant, Robin Corinne Konrad, resides in Alabama. There is a likelihood law enforcement may not be able to effectuate the Defendant's arrest if this Indictment does not remain sealed until the Indicted Defendant's arrest.

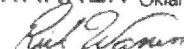

ORDER DETERMINING VENUE, SEALING INDICTMENT, REQUIRING TRANSMITTAL
OF INDICTMENT TO COUNTY OF VENUE, AND AUTHORIZING DISTRICT COURT TO
OPEN FOR PURPOSE OF ISSUANCE OF WARRANT

NOW on this 23rd day of July 2026, the Court having been presented, in open court, an Indictment returned by the Oklahoma Multi-County Grand Jury stemming from Case Number GJ-2024-310, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. Said indictment having been examined by the Court, the Court pursuant to the provisions of 22 O.S. § 385, finds and orders that venue and jurisdiction shall be in Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma.
2. That said indictment shall be transmitted by the Attorney General, or one of his Assistant Attorneys General, to the District Court Clerk of Pittsburg County, who, thereafter, upon receipt shall notify the District Judge of Pittsburg County of the filing of the same.
3. That the District Judge of Pittsburg County shall proceed according to the provisions of 22 O.S. § 386.
4. That said indictment may be unsealed by the District Judge of Pittsburg County for the purpose of issuing arrest warrants and thereafter shall remain sealed under the Order of the District Court of Pittsburg County until the defendant is arrested.
