IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twenty-Second Multi-County Grand Jury of Oklahoma was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from June 15, 2026, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multi-County Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire

into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: HUMAN TRAFFICKING FOR COMMERCIAL SEX ~ 21 O.S. § 748(A)(6) a FELONY

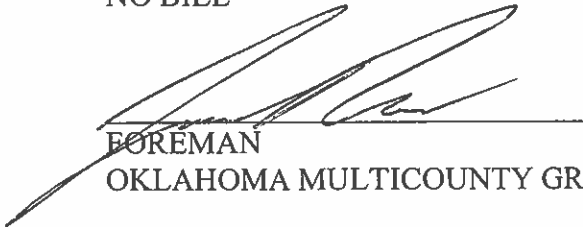
On or about or between March 10, 2026, and May 15, 2026, the crime of **HUMAN TRAFFICKING FOR COMMERCIAL SEX** was feloniously committed in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, by **AMARIO DEWAYNE CLAY**, who knowingly recruited, enticed, harbored, maintained, transported, provided, and/or obtained another person, to wit: H.B., through deception, force, fraud, threat, and/or coercion for purposes of engaging H.B. in a commercial sex act or acts with third parties, contrary to the provisions of Section 748(A)(6) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

FELONY**

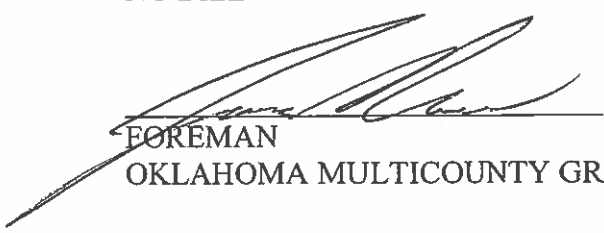
On or about or between March 10, 2026, and May 15, 2026, the crime of
**ACQUIRING PROCEEDS FROM ILLEGAL ACTIVITY, TO WIT: HUMAN
TRAFFICKING FOR COMMERCIAL SEX** was feloniously committed in Oklahoma
County, Oklahoma, by **AMARIO DEWAYNE CLAY**, who knowingly acquiring
proceeds, knowing those proceeds were derived from a violation of the Oklahoma Statutes,
to wit: Human Trafficking for Commercial Sex, and knowingly engaged in transaction
involving those proceeds, contrary to the provisions of Section 2001(A) of Title 21 of the
Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING FOR COMMERCIAL SEX ~ 21 O.S. § 1287, a
FELONY**

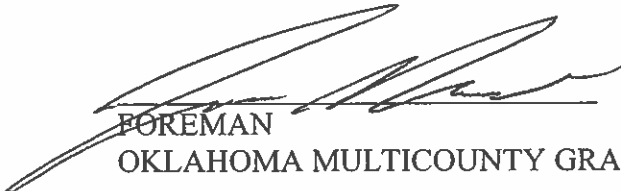
On or about or between March 10, 2026, and May 15, 2026, the crime of **USE OF
A FIREARM WHILE COMMITTING A FELONY TO WIT: HUMAN
TRAFFICKING FOR COMMERCIAL SEX** was feloniously committed in Oklahoma
County, Oklahoma, by **AMARIO DEWAYNE CLAY**, who knowingly and willfully
possessed a black Glock 43 x 9mm firearm, while committing Human Trafficking for
Commercial Sex, and the weapon was to be used either offensively or defensively in a
manner that would constitute a threat of harm, contrary to the provisions of Section 1287
of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of
Oklahoma.
