INDICTMENT

FOR:

COUNT 1: MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE BY FELONY MURDER ~ 21 O.S. § 701.7(B), a FELONY

OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE:

MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE ~ 21 O.S. § 701.8, a FELONY

COUNT 2: DISTRIBUTION OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, TO WIT: FENTANYL ~ 63 O.S. § 2-401, a FELONY

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury of Oklahoma was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from December 16, 2024, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multi-County Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire

into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (FELONY MURDER) ~ 21 O.S. § 701.7(B), a FELONY

On or about and between November 19, 2025 and November 20, 2025, in Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, **DJ SIMPSON** committed the crime of **MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE BY FELONY MURDER BY DISTRIBUTION OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE**, a Felony, by causing the death of **KAMBRI NEWSOM** resulting from the commission of the unlawful distribution of a controlled dangerous substance, to wit: Fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled dangerous substance, to **KAMBRI NEWSOM** in violation of Title 63 O.S. § 2-401, thereby inflicting mortal damage upon the body of **KAMBRI NEWSOM** from which mortal damage the same **KAMRBI NEWSOM** did languish and die of Fentanyl toxicity, contrary to the provisions of Section 701.7(B) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma;

OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE:

COUNT 1: MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE ~ 21 O.S. § 701.8, a FELONY

On or about and between November 19, 2025 and November 20, 2025, in Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, **DJ SIMPSON** committed the crime of **MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE**, a Felony, by perpetrating an act imminently dangerous to another person, to wit: distributing Fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled dangerous substance, to **KAMBRI NEWSOM**, evincing a depraved mind in extreme disregard of human life, which resulted in the death of **KAMBRI NEWSOM**, contrary to the provisions of Title 21 O.S. § 701.8, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 2: DISTRIBUTION OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, TO
WIT: FENTANYL ~ 63 O.S. § 2-401, a FELONY**

On or about or between November 19, 2025, and November 20, 2025, in Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, **DJ SIMPSON**, did commit the crime of **DISTRIBUTION OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE**, by unlawfully and knowingly distributing Fentanyl, to one **KAMBRI NEWSOM**, said drug being classified as a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of this State, contrary to the provisions of Title 63 O.S. § 2-401, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
