INDICTMENT

FOR:

COUNT 1: CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT LARCENY OF MERCHANDISE FROM A RETAILER ~ 21 O.S. § 421, a FELONY

COUNT 2: LARCENY OF MERCHANDISE FROM A RETAILER ~ 21 O.S. § 1731, a FELONY

COUNT 3: ENGAGING IN A PATTERN OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES ~ 21 O.S. § 425, a FELONY

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury of Oklahoma was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from December 16, 2024, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twenty-First Multi-County Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multi-County Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law,

and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT LARCENY OF MERCHANDISE FROM A RETAILER ~ 21 O.S. § 421, a FELONY

On or about or between December 5, 2025 and December 7, 2025, the crime of **CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT LARCENY OF MERCHANDISE FROM A RETAILER**, was committed by **ANGEL JONES** and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE**, who conspired with one another, by agreeing to steal merchandise from multiple Walmart Supercenter stores, located at the following addresses: 131 Paul Carr Drive, Checotah, Oklahoma 74426 (McIntosh County); 196 Shawnee Mall Drive, Shawnee, Oklahoma 74804 (Pottawatomie County); 5401 Tinker Diagonal Street, Del City, Oklahoma 73115 (Oklahoma County); 100 E. I-240 Service Road, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73149 (Oklahoma County); 333 N. Interstate Drive, Norman, Oklahoma 73069 (Cleveland County); 601 12th Avenue NE, Norman, Oklahoma 73071 (Cleveland County); 3651 Classen Boulevard, Norman, Oklahoma 73071 (Cleveland County); 3300 Tri City Drive, Newcastle, Oklahoma 73065 (McClain County); 1200 Garth Brooks Boulevard, Yukon, Oklahoma 73099 (Canadian County); 7800 Northwest Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73132 (Oklahoma County); 2200 W. Danforth Rd., Edmond, Oklahoma 73003 (Oklahoma County); 1225 W. I-35, Edmond, Oklahoma 73034 (Oklahoma County); 105 OK-16, Bristow, Oklahoma 74010 (Creek County); 6625 S. Memorial Drive, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74133 (Tulsa County); 11207 OK-51, Coweta, Oklahoma 74429 (Wagoner County); 19801 Robson Rd., Catoosa, Oklahoma 74015 (Rogers County); 4901 S. Mill Street, Pryor, Oklahoma 74361 (Mayes County); 268 S. 7th Street, Vinita, Oklahoma 74301 (Craig County); and 2415 N. Main Street,

Miami, Oklahoma 74354 (Ottawa County). More particularly, this scheme included a common design by which one or more members of the conspiracy would enter the Walmart Supercenter, utilize the Scan & Go feature by scanning a particular item at a lower cost, but then placing a higher priced item in the cart instead, thereby paying for the lower priced item, but leaving the store with the higher priced item, additionally, one or more members of the conspiracy would conceal sports trading cards inside of a copy paper box, pay for the copy paper, and leave the store without paying for the sports trading cards, acts which were in violation of Sections 1731 of Title 21, in a conspiracy that was contrary to the provisions of Section 421 of Title 21 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

In furtherance of their conspiracy, a member or members of the conspiracy did commit one or more of the following overt acts, including but not limited:


- a. On or about December 5, 2025, **ANGEL JONES** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Checotah, Oklahoma and selected two calculators, one at a value of \$139.00 and one at value of \$5.97. **ANGEL JONES** then utilized the Scan & Go feature and scanned and paid for the \$5.97 calculator, discarded it, and left the store with the \$139.00 calculator.
- b. On or about December 5, 2025, **ANGEL JONES** and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Shawnee, Oklahoma and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** selected six boxes of trading cards and placed them in a box of copy paper. Subsequently, **ANGEL JONES** selected various items, including the box of copy paper with the trading cards. **ANGEL JONES** utilized the Scan & Go feature and paid for items cheaper than the items she left the store with. **ANGEL JONES** left the store with the box of copy paper containing the stolen trading cards.
- c. On or about December 5, 2025, **ANGEL JONES** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Del City, Oklahoma and selected four calculators, three at a value of \$149.00 and one at a value of \$5.97. **ANGEL JONES** then utilized the Scan & Go feature, scanned the \$5.97 calculator three times, discarded it, paid for three of the \$5.97 calculators, and left the store with the three \$149.00 calculators.
- d. On or about December 6, 2025, **ANGEL JONES** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Yukon, Oklahoma and selected two calculators, one at a value of

\$149.00 and one at \$5.97. **ANGEL JONES** then utilized the Scan & Go feature, scanned the \$5.97 calculator, discarded it, paid for the \$5.97 calculator, and left the store with the \$149.00 calculator.

- e. On or about December 6, 2025, **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Edmond, Oklahoma and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** selected boxes of trading cards in an unknown amount and placed them in a box of copy paper. Subsequently, **ANGEL JONES** selected the box of copy paper with the trading cards. **ANGEL JONES** utilized the Scan & Go feature and paid for a box of copy paper cheaper than the item she scanned, and **ANGEL JONES** left the store with the box of copy paper containing the stolen trading cards.
- f. On or about December 7, 2025, **ANGEL JONES** and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Pryor, Oklahoma and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** selected six boxes of trading cards and placed them in a box of copy paper. Subsequently, **ANGEL JONES** selected the box of copy paper with the trading cards. **ANGEL JONES** utilized the Scan & Go feature and paid for a box of copy paper cheaper than the item she scanned, and **ANGEL JONES** left the store with the box of copy paper containing the stolen trading cards.

- g. On or about December 7, 2025, **ANGEL JONES** walked into the Walmart Supercenter in Vinita, Oklahoma and selected two calculators, one at a value of \$139.00 and one at \$5.97. **ANGEL JONES** then utilized the Scan & Go feature, scanned the \$5.97 calculator, discarded it, and left the store with one of the \$139.00 calculators.


COUNT 2: LARCENY OF MERCHANDISE FROM A RETAILER~ 21 O.S. § 1731, a FELONY

On or about or between December 5, 2025 and December 7, 2025, in McIntosh, Pottawatomie, Oklahoma, Cleveland, McClain, Canadian, Creek, Tulsa, Wagoner, Rogers, Mayes, Craig, and Ottawa Counties, the crime of **LARCENY OF MERCHANDISE FROM A RETAILER**, was committed by **ANGEL JONES** and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** by utilizing the Walmart Scan & Go feature at various Walmart Supercenter stores to fraudulently take and carry away from said Walmart Supercenter stores merchandise with an aggregate total value of over \$2,500 but less than \$15,000, to wit: calculators and/or trading cards, by scanning at the self-checkout counter lower priced items while placing higher priced items in their shopping cart or carts, and/or concealing higher priced items inside lower priced items used as decoys, thereby paying for the lower priced items, but leaving the stores with the higher priced items, with the intent to deprive these retailers of the merchandise permanently, contrary to the provisions of Section 1731 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.


COUNT 3: ENGAGING IN A PATTERN OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES ~ 21 O.S. § 425, a FELONY

On or about or between December 5, 2025 and December 7, 2025, the crime of **ENGAGING IN A PATTERN OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES** was feloniously committed by **ANGEL JONES** and **CHRISTOPHER LOEPKE** by perpetrating criminal offenses – including the crimes of conspiracy to commit larceny of merchandise from a retailer and larceny of merchandise from a retailer – in two or more counties in the State of Oklahoma, with said offenses occurring in McIntosh County, Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma County, Cleveland County, McClain County, Canadian County, Creek County, Tulsa County, Wagoner County, Rogers County, Mayes County, Craig County, and Ottawa County, and with such offenses being committed as part of the same plan, scheme, or adventure, and/or with such offenses each proceeding from or having antecedent a single prior incident or pattern of fraud, theft, or receipt of stolen property. Such pattern of offenses included acts which occurred at various locations as previously alleged. These acts constituted a pattern of criminal offenses contrary to the provisions of Section 425 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
