Amount of opioids distributed within the political subdivision in the last three years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not readily available at municipal or school district levels — requires specialized data request 	Opioid dispensing rate in the last three years	<p>Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select the county and years of interest • Obtain the total number of prescriptions dispensed in the past three years • Add the number of prescriptions for the past three years. Add population totals for the past three years. Using those totals, divide the total number of prescriptions for the past three years by population total for the past three years • Multiply the result by 100 to calculate the rate per 100 residents. This gives you an average rate of prescriptions over the three-year period
