27	For this reporting period, the data of 16 independently accredited Schools and 73 unaccredited Schools is being reported (total 89).								
28	This number represents ALL Schools licensed by the OBPVS as of June 30, 2018, <i>except</i> (7) non-Oklahoma and (11) Seminar-only Schools.								
29	For 2013/2014 the data reported included 21 and 2 Schools, respectively (total 23). <b>That is an increase of 289% in the number of Schools reporting.</b>								
30	However, such a large increase in the population of reporting Schools results in many statistical analyses being meaningless.								
31	<b>Out-of-State Schools NOT Counted, per the direction of the prior Cabinet Secretary for Education &amp; Workforce Development:</b> The (2)								
32	Lincoln Colleges of Technology in Nashville, TN and Grand Prairie, TX with HVAC, Diesel/Truck, Welding, and other Mechanical Programs;
