What is Plant Science Research?

This program involves basic research in plant productivity, renewable biomass, plant-based environmental applications and chemical platforms and plant-based solutions to improve nutrition, human or animal health to develop new products and services to form the basis of new, high-technology plant science and agriculture industries for Oklahoma.

Why Plant Science?

This program helps researchers gain the expertise and gather research data to support proposals for additional research funding. The program supports basic research that is necessary to advance plant-related science and collaborative efforts are encouraged to help support later stage applied plant research projects.

Funding Opportunity

- \$10,000 minimum per year
- \$50,000 maximum per year
- 1-2 years of funding


Who is Eligible to Apply?

- Oklahoma public or private colleges or universities
- Non-profit research institutions
- Private enterprises with the principal place of business in Oklahoma
