OCAST

- Funds industry innovation activities leading to an answer to the company's problem

- Has an employee who can serve as a qualified mentor
- Can demonstrate the project will provide excellent experience for students
- Will provide an on-site, applied learning and work experience to solve a real-world problem for the company
- Has a project with an end-user application in aerospace, autonomous systems, or defense, biotechnology, or energy diversification



FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

- \$10,000 minimum per year
- \$30,000 maximum per year
- 1-2 years of funding
