What is the Postdoctoral Fellowship?

The Oklahoma Health Research Postdoctoral Fellowship provides funding to support postdoctoral fellows pursuing increased scientific understanding of important problems in human health. The basic research funded under this program investigates the causes, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of human diseases and disabilities and facilitates the development of health care products and services, laying the foundation for economically significant future innovations.

Why should I apply?

- Receive up to \$75,000 per year
- Awards up to \$150,000 total funding
- Funding for 1 or 2 years
- No match required

Who is eligible?

1. Companies, foundations, institutions, or universities
2. At time of funding, postdoctoral fellows must
 - hold a doctoral degree
 - reside in Oklahoma
 - be a full-time employee of the applicant organization
3. Basic health research projects
