June 7, 2022 – 9:30 a.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on June 7, 2022, in Room 301 of the Commission’s principal offices at 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the Oklahoma City offices of the Commission at 1:45 p.m. June 3, 2022, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Dana L. Murphy. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman Murphy called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

Members present were Chairman Dana Murphy, Vice Chairman Bob Anthony, and Commissioner Todd Hiatt. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

The minutes were approved.

Consideration of and Possible Vote(s) on Proposed or Potential Orders in Causes on the Daily Signing Agenda Docket The daily signing agenda of proposed orders in judicial cases was presented by Amy L. Cummings, Commission Secretary. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders.

Consideration of and Possible Vote(s) on Proposed or Potential Orders in Causes on 24-hour Signing Agenda Docket The 24-hour signing agenda of proposed orders was presented by Ms. Cummings. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders.*

**At the time of voting on the 24-hour orders, the Commission had discussed only one order (PUD2021-000164). After taking up Agenda Item V (MCC), Commissioner Anthony sought clarification on whether all 24-hr orders had been included in the previous vote. Commissioner Murphy confirmed with Ms. Cummings that the proposed order for PUD2021-000164 was the*

only order on which votes were cast at the time the 24-hour Signing Agenda Docket item was first taken up and there was a need to vote on the remaining proposed orders on that docket. The Commissioners unanimously approved the remaining proposed orders.

Discussion of and possible vote(s) on a proposed Final Order of the Commission and/or any alternations, revisions, or amendments thereto proposed at the meeting, in Cause No. MCC 202222906, Oklahoma Corporation Commission vs. Respondents Named on Attached Docket Report “Exhibit A” Darren Ferguson, staff attorney for the Transportation Division, was recognized and announced the cause. Discussion was held. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed order.

Discussion of and possible vote(s) on an update to the duties and responsibilities of the director of administration, since those last adopted and dated effective July 1, 2012 Interim Director of Administration Brandy Wreath was recognized and submitted the following proposed update to the referenced duties and responsibilities.

**Duties and Responsibilities of
the Director of Administration
Update June 2022**

Effective June 7, 2022, the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (“Commission”) assigns to the Commission’s director of administration (a political appointee position as set forth under 62 Okla. Stat. § 34.301(H)(3)) and any successor director of administration, as provided by 17 Okla. Stat. § 32, the following duties and responsibilities:

- (1) Appointing Authority – to be named the appointing authority under state law;
- (2) Agency Approving Officer – to be named the agency approving officer, as defined by 62 Okla. Stat. §34.68, with bond as provided by 74 Okla. Stat. § 85.58Q;
- (3) Communication – to create and promote a productive, efficient and collaborative work environment. Ensure and plan for effective communication throughout the agency, in addition to providing effective communication to the Commissioners. Oversee interagency communications, emergency response plans and actions, and legislative liaison duties on behalf of the Commission;
- (4) Fiscal Duties – to ensure compliance with budgetary processes, audit recommendations and reporting. Oversee agency/risk management; contract for all independent professional or other service; purchase, lease or otherwise contract for all equipment, supplies, vehicles, and other personal property; lease all real property; and enter into Memoranda of Understanding and agreements with other governmental entities and/or offices as deemed necessary, expedient, convenient, or appropriate

under the Commission’s strategic plan, the laws of the State of Oklahoma, the rules of the Commission and any other applicable law;

(5) Internal Processes and Procedures, and Strategic Effectiveness – to establish and update internal procedures and processes for overall attainment and reporting of the Commission’s strategic plan; manage the agency’s operations to provide for and support appropriate and effective administration of the areas within the Commission; and ensure compliance under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, the rules of the Commission, and any other applicable law;

(6) Personnel – to employ, discharge, appoint, and approve the duties and compensation of all personnel as set forth under the Commission’s strategic plan (except for the director of administration and each Commissioner’s administrative aide and executive secretary) either on a full-time, part-time, fee, or contractual basis, as in the director of administration’s judgment and discretion are deemed necessary, expedient, convenient, or appropriate under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, the rules of the Commission, and any other applicable law;

(7) Reports – to coordinate the preparation and submission of reports to the Commission, Governor, Legislature, and/or others regarding the Commission’s operations, budget, and performance, or other appropriate subjects; and

(8) Other Duties – to obtain input from and perform other functions as the Commission may assign from time to time.

The director of administration reports directly to the Commission. In taking action to fulfill the duties and responsibilities noted above, the director of administration shall advise the Commission as needed and appropriate. The duties and responsibilities set forth above may be modified, superseded, or withdrawn by action of the Commission. In the event of the director of administration’s temporary absence, the director of administration may delegate the exercise of such duties and responsibilities to a designee during the temporary absence upon notice to the Commission.

The proposed update to the duties and responsibilities of the director of administration was approved.



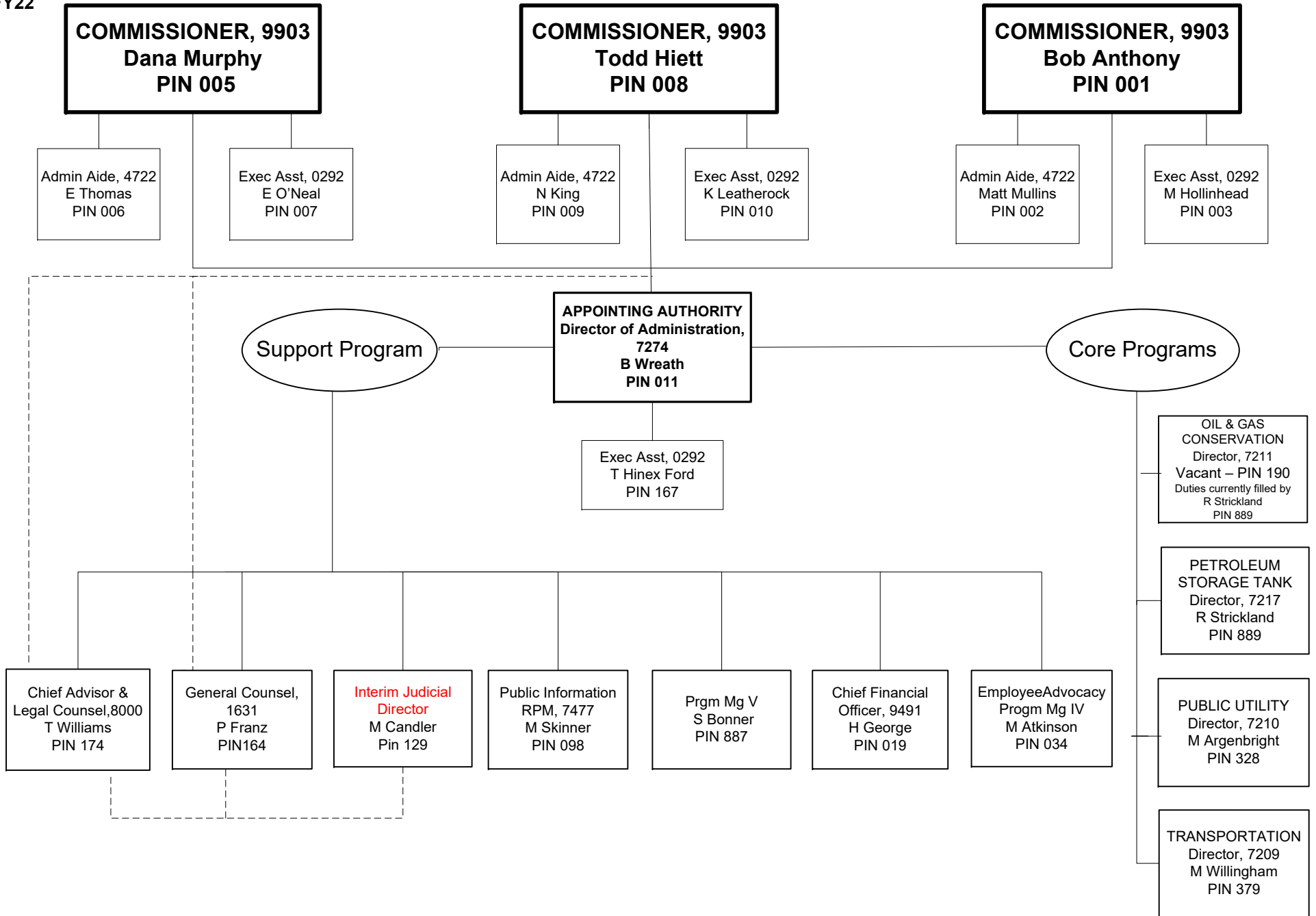
