

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

November 3, 2022 – 1:30 p.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission's ("Commission") regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on November 3, 2022, in Room 301 of the Commission's principal offices at 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission's website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the Oklahoma City offices of the Commission at 2:30 p.m. November 1, 2022, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Dana L. Murphy. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission's website, oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman Murphy called the meeting to order at 1:31 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Dana Murphy, Vice Chairman Bob Anthony, and Commissioner Todd Hiatt. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Hearing on the merits before the Commission en banc with a referee in Case No. PUD 2022-000097, Application of Mark Argenbright, Director of the Public Utility Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission, for a Show Cause Hearing and Commission Determination Regarding Proposed Fuel Cost Adjustment Charges of Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company Commissioner Murphy announced the agenda item and recognized James Myles, referee, who opened the record and took appearances. Commissioners Murphy and Hiatt exited the room at 2:21 p.m. All interested parties were given an opportunity to provide public comments regarding the case. Commissioners Murphy and Hiatt reentered the room at 2:25 p.m. and the case proceeded with the testimony of the witnesses.

Recess was taken from 3:01p.m. to 3:16 p.m. during the testimony of Oklahoma Gas and Electric ("OG&E") witness Donald R. Rowlett. Commissioners Murphy, Anthony, Hiatt, and Referee Myles were present when the meeting resumed with Mr. Rowlett's testimony.

Recess was taken from 4:38 p.m. to 4:50 p.m. during the testimony of OG&E witness Rowlett. Commissioners Murphy, Anthony, Hiatt, and Referee Myles were present in the room when the meeting resumed with the continued testimony of Mr. Rowlett.

The meeting recessed at 6:01 p.m., to be resumed at 8:30 a.m., November 4, 2022, in Room 301.


The meeting resumed on November 4, 2022, at 8:31 a.m., with Commissioners Murphy and Hiatt present. Referee Myles opened the record.

At the conclusion of Mr. Rowlett’s testimony, a recess was taken from 9:47 a.m. to 10:02 a.m. with Commissioners Murphy and Hiatt present when reconvened.

Commissioner Murphy exited the room at 11:21 a.m. prior to Oklahoma Industrial Energy Consumers (“OIEC”) witness, Scott Norwood’s testimony beginning.


The meeting recessed at 12:02 p.m., to be resumed at 1:00 p.m.
