

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

January 18, 2023 – 1:30 p.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on January 18, 2023, in Room 301 of the Commission’s principal office at 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the principal office of the Commission at the Jim Thorpe Building, 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 11:30 a.m. January 13, 2023, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Todd Hiatt. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman Hiatt called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Todd Hiatt, Vice Chairman Bob Anthony, and Commissioner Kim David. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Technical conference to discuss and allow for public comment in Case No. CD2022-005088 Application of Robyn Strickland Director of Oil and Gas Conservation Division Oklahoma Corporation Commission for Statewide Proration Formula for Unallocated Gas Wells for the Period of April 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024 Commissioner Hiatt recognized Tyler Trout, staff attorney for the Oil and Gas Conservation Division, who provided an update. All interested parties were given an opportunity to provide comments. Discussion was held. No votes were taken.

Consideration of and Possible Vote(s) on Proposed or Potential Orders in Cases on 24-hour Signing Agenda Docket The 24-hour signing agenda of proposed orders was presented by Amy L. Cummings, Commission secretary. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders.


After discussion of agenda item IV, Commissioner Hiatt revisited agenda item III to confirm that Ms. Cummings had the correct orders for Case PUD2022-000121, in which she confirmed.

Consideration, discussion, and review of the process by which the Commission reviews and monitors application of fuel adjustment clauses, including monthly reviews and annual public hearings, as well as the process for conducting prudency reviews of generation, purchased power, and fuel procurement processes and costs. Consideration and discussion of Oklahoma statutes, including 17 O.S. §§ 250 - 264, and Commission rules, including OAC

165:35, 45, and 50, relating to fuel and prudence reviews, including the definition of “prudence review.” Consideration and discussion will include 2021 Winter Storm Uri, normalized costs, securitization, tariffs, fuel factor adjustment, and the Commission’s authority to review for prudence or other reasons any utility contract Commissioner Hiett announced the agenda item and recognized Commissioner Anthony. Commissioner Anthony requested Mike Velez, deputy general counsel for the Public Utility Division, provide information on the upcoming process and the responsibilities of the Commission. Discussion was held. No votes were taken.

Consideration, discussion, and vote adopting a Statement that: “A Commissioner shall have access to Commission records” Commissioner Anthony announced the agenda item. Discussion was held. Teryl Williams, chief advisor and legal counsel for the Commission, and Brandy Wreath, director of administration, were recognized. Discussion was held. No votes were taken.
