These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on July 31, 2024, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 12:05 p.m., July 30, 2024, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman J. Chairman Hiatt called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

**The Public Information Office has informed me that our agency has received at least two Open Records Requests about or related to “allegedly drunken and/or inappropriate behavior at the Mid-America Regulatory Conference in Minnesota in June.” To my knowledge, to date, this agency has not denied that it has responsive records, but no records have yet been provided. According to a response sent by the OCC PIO to a requestor, a “whistleblower” statute is being invoked to justify the withholding. Please confirm for me if such a designation has been made, and if so, please explain by whom, when, and basically on what grounds.**

**Please note that I am not requesting either the identity of the person the OCC has designated as a whistleblower or the substantive contents of the records. I am asking questions about the process utilized thus far regarding these Open Records Requests.**

**Thank you for your assistance.**

**Possible related topics include the Open Records Act, the Civil Service and Human Capital Modernization Act, the Confidential Whistleblower Program, Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and related statutes and/or legal definitions.** Commissioner Hiatt announced the agenda item and deferred to Commissioner Anthony to present this item. Commissioner Anthony recognized Brandy Wreath, director of administration, to offer clarification on a pending Open Records Request being handled as subject to the provisions of the Whistleblower statute. Discussion was held. Commissioner David requested that Mr. Wreath investigate the possibility of the OCC securing the services of an independent investigator from the Oklahoma Civil Service Division.


