

**Minutes of the  
Oklahoma Corporation Commission  
State of Oklahoma**

**December 4, 2025 – 1:30 p.m.**

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on December 4, 2025, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 12:30 p.m., December 2, 2025, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, [oklahoma.gov/occ](http://oklahoma.gov/occ). A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiett, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

**Consideration of and possible vote(s) on proposed or potential orders in cases on attached 24- hour signing agenda docket. The Commission may discuss and consider alterations, revisions, or amendments to the proposed or potential orders. (Votes may be taken on individual cases on the 24-hour signing agenda docket as a whole, or both by individual cases and the remaining docket.)** Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Garey Wortham, commission secretary, to present the item for approval. Discussion was held. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders.

**Technical Conference and Public Comment in Case No. RM2025-000002, In the Matter of a Permanent Rulemaking of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission Amending OAC 165:10, Oil & Gas Conservation** Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Melissa Scimeca, deputy general counsel for the Oil and Gas Conservation Division, to conduct the technical conference. Ms. Scimeca provided a procedural history on this item. Comments were offered by persons present in Suite C50, but none were offered by persons online. Mike McGinnis, deputy director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Division, responded to public comments and offered clarification of the proposed rules. This concluded the technical conference.

**Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Docket No. RM26-4-000, Interconnection of Large Load to the Interstate Transmission System, discussion and possible vote(s) to support the Reply Comments of the Oklahoma Attorney General’s Office, and/or any alterations, revisions, or amendments thereto proposed at the meeting** Commissioner David announced the agenda item and gave a status update on this matter. Commissioner David **MADE A MOTION** *“that our signatures be affixed to the document titled, “Reply Comments of the Oklahoma Attorney General’s Office and the Oklahoma Corporation Commission,” and that the document be filed*

with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in Docket No. RM26-4-000.” Commissioner David **CALLED FOR VOTE** on the motion.

**Case No. PUD2025-000038, In the Matter of the Application of Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company for Commission Preapproval of New Generation Capacity Pursuant to 17 O.S. § 286(C) and Rider Cost Recovery**

**Discussion of Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company’s Request for Commissioner Todd Hiatt to Recuse filed on November 26, 2025** Commissioner David announced the agenda item and deferred to Commissioner Hiatt to present this item. Commissioner Hiatt offered a statement of position in which he declined to recuse himself from this matter. A request was made by A. Chase Snodgrass, legal counsel for Oklahoma Gas and Electric, to offer a rebuttal statement to Commissioner Hiatt’s statement. Discussion was held. Although no vote of the Commission was taken on Mr. Snodgrass’ request, Commissioners David and Bingman deferred to Commissioner Hiatt whether to allow Mr. Snodgrass to offer a rebuttal statement. Commissioner Hiatt stated that the agenda item was not posted for response from any parties. Therefore, no rebuttal statement was permitted.

**Discussion, possible hearing, and possible vote(s) on Oklahoma Industrial Energy Consumers and AARP’s Motion to Reconsider and Modify Order No. 753440** The Commissioners unanimously agreed to hear *Oklahoma Industrial Energy Consumers and AARP’s Motion to Reconsider and Modify Order No. 753440*. Commissioner David took appearances from parties and proceeded with oral arguments and rebuttal arguments. Discussion was held. No vote was taken on this motion, and the matter was taken under advisement.
