

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

December 15, 2025 – 8:30 a.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on December 15, 2025, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 3:00 p.m., December 10, 2025, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Carly Ortel opened the meeting at 8:30 a.m. in Suite C50, Concourse Theater of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building. No Commissioners were present at this time. Therefore, no quorum of the Commission existed.

Proceedings before an ALJ, including public comment and a hearing on the merits, which may include any potential stipulation and settlement agreement(s) filed in Case No. PUD2025-00028, *In the Matter of the Application of Summit Utilities Oklahoma, Inc. for a Review and Change or Adjustment of its Rates, Charges, Tariffs and Terms and Conditions of Service, and Request for Waivers*

ALJ Ortel reopened the record on the merits hearing in Case No. PUD2025-000028. ALJ Ortel opened the floor for public comment, but no comments were offered by persons in Suite C50 or online. ALJ Ortel announced that the meeting was continued to 10:00 a.m. on this date in Suite C50, Concourse Theater of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building.

Chairman David reconvened the meeting at 10:01 a.m. in Suite C50. Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

ALJ Ortel reopened the record on the merits hearing of Case No. PUD2025-000028 and proceeded to take testimony from the witnesses as well as a statement from legal counsel for the Public Utility Division. ALJ Ortel recommended that the Commission approve the joint stipulation. ALJ Ortel announced that the hearing on the merits is now closed and turned the meeting back over to Commissioner David.
