

**Minutes of the

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on March 9, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 10:00 a.m., March 4, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, oklahoma.gov/occ. Commissioner David called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiett, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.


Public comment and a hearing on the merits before an ALJ in Case No. PUD2025-000069, In the Matter of the Application of AEP Oklahoma Transmission Company, Inc. for a Certificate of Authority Permitting it to Rebuild Electric Transmission Facilities Located in Carter, Comanche, and Stephens Counties Commissioner David announced the agenda item and turned the meeting over to Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Carly Ortel to conduct proceedings. ALJ Ortel opened the record on proceedings in Case No. PUD2025-000069 and took appearances from the parties. ALJ Ortel opened the floor for public comment, but none was offered by persons present in Suite C50 or online. ALJ Ortel addressed any pretrial issues and proceeded to hear witness testimony. At the conclusion of witness testimony, ALJ Ortel made a recommendation that the Commission grant the application in this matter and turned the meeting back over to Commissioner David.
