These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on March 11, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 11:00 a.m., March 10, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, Oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Commissioner David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Approval or minutes or prior meeting(s) Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Garey Wortham, commission secretary, to present the minutes for approval. Mr. Wortham presented for consideration the minutes for January 27, 2026, at 1:30 p.m., February 4, 2026, at 1:30 p.m., February 5, 2026, at 8:30 a.m., February 17, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., February 18, 2026, at 1:30 p.m., February 25, 2026, at 2:30 p.m., and March 5, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. The Commissioners unanimously approved the minutes, with the exception of Commissioner David’s non-participation in the approval of the February 5, 2026, meeting minutes, due to her absence from that meeting.

At 1:32 p.m. Commissioner David announced that the meeting was in recess until 1:37 p.m. on this date.

At 1:37 p.m. Commissioner David reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners in attendance in Suite C50.

Educational presentations and discussion on Advanced Transmission Technologies and other grid-enhancing technologies in Oklahoma Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Leah Ford, Senior Associate with the PEW Charitable Trusts, Kelt Wilska, Senior Manager of State Policy for Advanced Transmission Technologies, Jay Caspary, Principal with TransGrid Advisors, and Theodore Paradise, Chief Policy and Grid Strategy Officer with CTC Global, to present expert information related to advanced transmission and grid-enhancing technologies which might provide efficient energy supply benefits for the State of Oklahoma. Discussion was held.

At 2:16 p.m. Commissioner David left the meeting. Commissioner Hiatt conducted the remainder of the proceedings with Commissioner Bingman also still in attendance. Discussion was held.


New Business There was no new business.
