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Media Advisory – Medford area earthquake

Following a 4.5 magnitude earthquake (Oklahoma Geological Survey's measure) today in the Medford area, the Oklahoma Corporation Commission's (OCC) Induced Seismicity Department is directing 3 oil and gas wastewater disposal wells to stop operations until further notice.

The earthquake occurred within the 15,000 square mile earthquake Area of Interest (AOI), where disposal into the Arbuckle formation has been drastically reduced as part of the earthquake mitigation effort by the OCC. Researchers are in broad agreement that the huge increase of disposal of oil and gas wastewater into the Arbuckle formation within the AOI starting in about 2013 can be linked to earthquake activity that peaked in 2016 and has since been declining, largely as a result of OCC mitigation measures.
