## INSTRUCTIONS

- A. A representative of the operator shall be on the discharge site at all times during which water is being applied.
- B. Surface owner approval must be obtained prior to discharge to land.
- C. Weather restrictions for surface discharge to land:
  - 1. During precipitation events or when precipitation is imminent;
  - 2. When the soil moisture content is at a level such that the soil would not readily take the additional water;
  - 3. When the ground is frozen; or
  - 4. By spray irrigation when the wind velocity is such that even distribution of water be accomplished or the buffer zones below cannot be maintained.
- D. No runoff or ponding of discharged water shall be allowed during application.
- E. Buffer zones for surface discharge to land:
  - 1. 50 feet from a property line boundary;
  - 2. 300 feet from any actively-producing water well used for domestic or irrigation purposes; and
  - 3. 800 feet from any actively-producing water well used for municipal purposes.
