RE: Oklahoma Energy Security Act and Hydrogen Fuel Production Standard, 17 O.S. § 801.9(B)

Governor Stitt, President Pro Tempore Paxton and Speaker Hibert:

In accordance with the Oklahoma Energy Security Act and the Hydrogen Fuel Production Standard, 17 O.S. § 801.9(B), the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (“Commission”) reports that there are currently zero hydrogen fuel production facilities in the State reporting to the Commission. The annual hydrogen fuel produced by qualified hydrogen fuel production facilities for the calendar year 2025 is zero.
