The Military Aviation and Installation Assurance Siting Clearinghouse (The Clearinghouse) has reviewed the Diamond Spring wind project in Mill Creek, OK. The Clearinghouse found no adverse impacts to DoD missions in the area and has entered a determination of "No Objection with Provision" via the Federal Aviation Administration's Obstruction Evaluation / Airport Airspace Analysis system.

Our response to the FAA included a notification that further expansion beyond the current project area may be problematic due to proximity to military training routes or military training areas. We also request installation of Night Vision Goggle compatible lighting on all structures associated with this project.
