A. If a motor carrier holds a current intrastate for-hire motor carrier license or intrastate private carrier license, the year the license becomes effective is the year of the identification device (left side of the identification device reflects the year) issued.

- B. Every vehicle operating in intrastate commerce for-hire or private is required to carry a current identification device. The stamp carried inside the vehicle should be affixed to a for-hire license, private carrier license or a certificate.
- C. Identification devices are effective when issued.

- E. Identification Device is valid until the intrastate for-hire motor carrier license or intrastate private carrier license expires.
