In state fiscal year 2019, Oklahoma had 81,249 total referrals for child abuse and neglect in which 138,907 children were alleged victims (OKDHS, 2020). It is critical that professionals and the public, alike, are knowledgeable about the basics of child abuse and neglect, and mandatory reporting laws in Oklahoma to better protect all children.
