## It Takes a Team to Protect a Child: CPT Investigation Strategies

Many communities realize the value of a coordinated response to child maltreatment. Understanding that the protection of physically and sexually abused or neglected children is inextricably bound to the ability of a multidisciplinary team (i.e., Law Enforcement, Child Protective Services, Prosecution, Mental Health, Health Care, and Advocates) to work collaboratively toward a common goal - the protection of children.

This is a skills-based workshop wherein participants will learn investigative techniques designed for multidisciplinary team members. Coordination, intervention, and the importance of collaboration will be stressed. The presentation will include a discussion of critical areas of interdisciplinary cooperation, such as multidisciplinary team response to outcry.
