Mr. Glen Huff attended the meeting via videoconference, however, he did not participate in the meeting.

Mr. Adams called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. Roll was called and a quorum was established.

- Update from the Chief Medical Examiner, Dr. Eric Pfeifer

Financial snapshot –

~ Dr. Pfeifer announced that the agency issued another check in the amount of \$500K to Oklahoma State University for the Tulsa building project.

He also advised, there are no other updates.

- Update from the Chief Administrative Officer, Amy Elliott

Cherokee Nation v. McKesson Corporation update

~ The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) received a subpoena in the Cherokee Nation v. McKesson Corporation lawsuit. The subpoena directed OCME to release a list of items to the Plaintiff's attorney. Mrs. Elliott advised the Board that on Monday, November 30th, she and Kari Learned met

virtually with Devan Pederson and Desiree Singer who are with the Attorney General's Office. The call was to discuss the subpoena and obtain clarification of some of the items being requested.

The Plaintiffs are requesting information regarding the death of tribal members within 14 specific counties. The agency will provide data on all opioid related deaths in these counties and allow the Plaintiff to determine whether or not a decedent is a tribal member. Another item listed in the subpoena is email communication between OCME and the Cherokee Nation.

Mr. Pederson placed a call to the Plaintiff's attorney, Susan Huntsman during the conference call to obtain additional information. Ms. Huntsman will email Mr. Pederson the specific list of drugs they are looking for as well as names for the email search. The email search request will be submitted to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES). They will perform the search and provide the results to OCME.

Our database administrator, Tod Hardin with DiscoverSoft has also been advised of the request and will perform the database search and provide the results to OCME.

- Discussion, possible action and possible Executive Session regarding the Chief Administrative Officer.

Mr. Adams opened the floor for a motion to enter into Executive Session. A motion was made by Mr. McElvany to enter into executive session for the purpose of discussing the performance, evaluation and employment of the Chief Administrative Officer. Dr. Allen seconded the motion, roll was called and all were in favor.
