\_\_\_\_\_ **Quality of Life Committee:** Addresses societal issues impacting women, Identifies studies and reports related to the status of women, monitors relevant legislation, plans Community Conversations and Summits, coordinates Girl Scout Troop #1921 involvement, and collaborates with quality of life-related state agencies, such as Mental Health and Health departments. A subcommittee on educating college and high school students on the early signs of human trafficking is part of this committee.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Economic Opportunities:** Addresses economic empowerment, workforce development, gender pay equity, educational requirements, appointments to state boards and commissions, monitors economic-related legislation, identifies research reports related to economic disparities for women, collaborates with economic and workforce state agencies, such as Commerce and Labor departments.

**Advisory Council Participation Requirement:**

1. Participate in at least three meetings or events per fiscal year (July 1-June 30), including committee meetings. If an Advisory Council member has not fulfilled this requirement within one fiscal year, the Commission will unfortunately need to remove the member from the Advisory Council due to the maximum number of members and to allow room for other experts who can be involved at this minimum level. If an Advisory Council member is removed, we encourage the member to reapply for membership. After a member’s three-year term expires, the member may reapply for another term on the Advisory Council.

2. Collaborate with the Commission in recognizing topics of key issues facing Oklahoma women, by assisting with Community Conversations and Summits.

3. Support the Commission’s committees and annual events.

4. Identify and recommend other activities to create more visibility and involvement from women across the state.
