- Emergency shelter
- Hotel or motel paid for with emergency shelter funds or short term stay funds or any type of funding
- Place not meant for habitation (vehicle, abandoned building, tent, street)

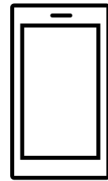
