

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)**

## **SH-412B and US-412 Interchange J/P 35050(04)**

### **What is ODOT planning to do?**

ODOT plans to improve the intersection of SH-412B and US-412 by building a new interchange. This will help drivers move through the area more safely and smoothly. The project will include:

- A new bridge over US-412
- New ramps to help traffic flow better
- Better connections on, off and across SH-412B and US-412
- Stop signs at the new ramp intersections

### **Will ODOT need to buy my property?**

No, ODOT does not need to buy any additional land for this project. The work will stay within the land they already own.

### **Will ODOT need temporary access to my property?**

No, ODOT does not expect to need temporary access to anyone's property for construction.

### **When will construction start?**

Construction is planned to begin in 2027.

### **How will this project affect my daily drive?**

All lanes will remain open on US-412 during construction, except for times when temporary lane closures are needed. SH-412B north of US-412 will remain open during construction. The road south of US-412 will not be open during construction. You may notice:

- Slower speed limits
- Some delays

- More traffic and congestion
- Longer travel times

### **Will I still be able to reach my home, business, or property?**

Yes, you'll still be able to get to your property. All lanes will remain open on US-412 during construction, except for times when temporary lane closures are needed. SH-412B north of US-412 will remain open during construction.

### **What happens next?**

- ODOT is hosting an Open House meeting on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at The Bunker in the District, 3822 W. 530, Pryor, OK 74361 from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.
- You can share your comments with ODOT until April 21, 2026.
- Construction is planned for 2027.
- The new interchange is scheduled to open in 2028.
