# 140. Director's Report – Information Only

Chief Engineer, TJ Dill began the Director's Report by welcoming Caleb and Terri McCaleb and recognized a new memorial interchange at I-35 and 33rd Street in Edmond was officially named in honor of Ambassador Neal McCaleb. Dill acknowledged that while ODOT is responsible for signage, the legislative process required to make the naming official was driven by Senator Jack Stewart and Senator Darcy Jech, both of whom were present. Senator Stewart delivered heartfelt remarks about the legacy of Neal McCaleb, citing his service under Governors Bellmon and Keating, his career in the legislature, and his influence on both Oklahoma's infrastructure and community development.

Dill transitioned to a technical presentation on Oklahoma's bridge inspection program, State Bridge Engineer Jason Giebler gave a detailed overview of the inspection process, federal requirements, training protocols, and data reporting systems. He explained that the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS) and the Specifications for the National Bridge Inventory (SNBI) govern how bridges are evaluated. Giebler reported that Oklahoma currently inspects approximately 23,000 County bridges, down from 33,000 due to replacements, and affirmed that ODOT meets or exceeds all federal requirements. He noted that ODOT inspects bridges at a maximum 24-month interval, with some inspected more frequently due to special circumstances such as scour, damage, or fracture-critical status. The inspection process includes specialized equipment, divers for underwater inspections, and extensive documentation. Giebler emphasized that only 35 on-system bridges are currently rated as "poor," and even those are under close monitoring. He credited strategic inspection data and asset management tools with helping the State advance from 49th to 4th in national bridge condition rankings for the approximately 6,800 bridges under ODOT's jurisdiction. Chairman Peterson and Commissioner Alexander commended ODOT staff and the legislature for their roles in this progress. Alexander remarked on the pride he felt in the Department's success, while Peterson emphasized the critical role of legislative funding in enabling these achievements.

Dill provided updates on the 8 Year Construction Work Plan (CWP), which is being rebalanced in response to ongoing inflation. He explained that the National Highway Construction Cost Index showed that the state had experienced the equivalent of 18 years of cost inflation in just four years (2021-2024), largely due to post-COVID economic conditions. Dill shared that individual district reviews were ongoing and the final version of the plan would be presented at the October Commission meeting for review and approval.

Dill also reported that the Texas Transportation Commission had approved a one-time \$3.5 million allocation to continue Heartland Flyer operations for another year. However, he stressed that the funding gap remains a concern, as Oklahoma contributes \$2.85 million annually while expenses total closer to \$5 million. Discussions with legislators will continue as both states work toward long-term solutions.

The Commission received updates on several upcoming construction projects:

District Eight, Tulsa County, S-75 in Glenpool, a new bridge at 141st Street was opened to eliminate a longstanding bottleneck. The project created a continuous, stoplight-free 84-mile corridor from Bartlesville to Okmulgee.

Also in District Eight, Mayes County near Chouteau, a \$27 million full-depth pavement replacement of six miles of southbound lanes is scheduled to begin in early 2026 and continue through summer 2027. This project will include significant traffic disruption with head-to-head traffic in the northbound lanes.

District Two, McCurtain County near Idabel on SH-37, a \$17 million project to resurface and add shoulders over six miles will begin early 2026, addressing increased tourist traffic to Hochatown and Broken Bow.

District Seven, Murray County near Sulphur on SH-7, a widening and bridge replacement project will begin in early 2026. It includes new 12-foot driving lanes, 8-foot shoulders, and a new bridge over Mill Creek, addressing traffic from the Chickasaw National Recreation Area and Turner Falls.

In the closing portion of his report, Dill addressed safety issues, beginning with the upcoming "See Tracks? Think Trains" week, which will be held from September 15–21, 2025. This initiative, formerly Rail Safety Week, is in partnership with Operation Lifesaver and aims to raise awareness of rail crossing dangers. He shared alarming national statistics, including one person or vehicle being struck by a train every three hours.

Dill then shifted to a somber topic, updating the Commission on a recent fatal accident involving ODOT and OTA personnel on the Will Rogers Turnpike. Zach, an OTA worker, was killed after being struck by

a semi-truck while removing debris. Corey Armstrong, who was inside the vehicle at the time of impact, survived and is currently recovering. Dill expressed deep sympathy to the families affected and emphasized the need for stricter adherence to work zone safety protocols, including speed limits. He referenced an incident where a driver was clocked at over 90 mph in a work zone, reinforcing the urgent need for legislative, enforcement, and technological measures to protect road workers.

Commissioner Don Freymiller echoed Dill's concerns, emphasizing that without increased enforcement, especially on the commercial vehicle side, rules and signage would have limited effect in improving highway safety.

Dill concluded by reiterating ODOT's commitment to work zone safety and education, noting that the agency would be increasing its outreach efforts and advocacy in coming months to change behaviors and reduce fatalities.

#### **District IV, Kay County – Rudy Construction Company**

**a)** This enhancement contract was awarded by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to Rudy Construction CO. for a total contract amount of \$790,029.48. Contract time was 90 calendar days.

The contractor was asked to rework a portion of the park pond shelf due to it not functioning as the plans intended and not allowing the pond to fill to capacity. The cost for this work totaled \$140,488.70.

Due to this amount causing the total additional appropriations to exceed the statutory limit of 15% on projects of \$1 million or less, Commission approval is needed.

The Department recognizes the entitlement for this claim, and is recommended that the Commission authorize a settlement in the amount of \$22,478.19

#### <u>District VII, Delaware County - H & G Paving Contractors Inc.</u>

- **b)** The Oklahoma Transportation Commission awarded a contract to H & G Paving Contractors Inc. (H & G) on July 11, 2022, to construct a roundabout at the intersection of US-412/US-59/SH-10 in Delaware County. The awarded amount was \$992,648.74 with a contract time of 60 calendar days. Time charges began on November 7, 2022.
- H & G initially failed to perform the required work within the specified time frame and ultimately did not complete the work at all. Over the course of two years, multiple attempts were made to correct H&G's lack of performance, but these efforts were ultimately unsuccessful, as all progress on the project had ceased. In accordance with Section 108.10 of the ODOT Standard Specifications, the project was declared in default. ODOT then called upon H & G's performance bond and made demand for the Surety to cause the remaining work on the project to be completed.

The Surety has selected a new contractor to complete the remaining work. New unit processes were established for the remaining work due to the cost escalations that have been realized since the contract was initially awarded. The new bid amount for the remaining work is \$969,078.00, of which \$587,863.05 will be funded by the Surety and \$ 279,716.95 will be funded with the remaining dollars on the original contract. A supplemental appropriation of \$101,498.00 is required to fund the remaining reclassified items.

Because the requested amount exceeds the statutory limit of 15% on new projects of \$1 million or less, Commission approval is necessary.

The Department recognizes the entitlement for this claim, and it is recommended that the Commission authorize a settlement of \$101,498.00.
