These projects are located in multiple counties and are included in the 8 Year Construction Work Plan. Funding will be 80% federal funds and 20% soft match credit. The combined programmed estimate for the construction of these projects is \$10,115,665.00.
 - b) Statewide Multiple Districts Bridge and Approach Projects (EC-1281) Four engineering firms have been selected to support the Department staff to advance the project development activities for eight bridge and approach projects. These projects are located in multiple counties and are included in the 8 Year Construction Work Plan. Funding will be 80% federal funds and 20% soft match credit. The combined programmed estimate for the construction of these projects is \$27,598,524.00.
