Division 2

- Atoka Co., SH-3, BRFY-103A(089)SS. Funds the overrun and addition of items required to complete the tie-in on the East end of the project. The existing roadway was converted from a two-lane to four-lane during construction of this project. Funds the striping and signing items required to complete this project but which were not shown or accounted for in the plans. Approximate cost is \$669,294.00 or 5.26% of the contract amount.

Division 3

- Pottawatomie Co., SH-9/US-270, STPY-163B(357)SG. Funds the overrun of items required to complete these projects as planned due to omitting quantities from one job when the two were combined. Funds the additional asphalt required for temporary widening to maintain traffic through work zone. Funds the Cl. AA Concrete to complete the RCB due to half of the quantities being omitted. Funds the Cl. C Concrete to provide erosion control in the ditches. Approximate cost is \$425,000.00 or 34.5% of the contract amount.

Division 4

Funds three Internal Milestone - #3 for ITS work, #4 to switch westbound traffic, and #5 for the two westbound lanes for the Robinson exit. Add the pay item to disassemble and transport high mast towers to an ODOT yard. Approximate cost is \$808,725.00 or 2.8% of the contract amount.
