9. Item No. 14 - Additions to the Industrial Access Road Program – Mr. Surrett

a) Garfield County - District IV

The City of Enid is requesting approval for an industrial access project for the Enid Woodring Regional Airport. The City of Enid, the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission, Vance Air Force Base and the Enid Woodring Regional Airport are partnering in a project totaling \$5,800,000.00 to extend the runway at the airport and relocate a county road.

The City will be responsible for the initiation, construction and completion of all work associated with the road project. The Department's participation in the project shall not exceed **\$500,000.00**.

b) Garvin County - District III

The Garvin County Commissioners are requesting approval for an industrial access project for Forum Energy Technologies. Forum is investing over \$9,000,000.00 in the expanding facility and creating 45 new full-time jobs.

The proposed project begins at SH-29 on NS3120 and extends south approximately 625 feet, then west for approximately 1875 feet, then back north approximately 625 feet. The County will be responsible for the initiation, construction and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation in the project shall not exceed \$200,000.00.
