## SUBJECT: ODOT receives first place in Oklahoma Asphalt Pavement Awards

The Oklahoma Asphalt Pavement Association recently awarded Oklahoma Department of Transportation's Districts 5 and 6 with a total of three first place awards at its $50^{\text {th }}$ Annual Awards Ceremony Luncheon in Norman in February.

The projects are judged using hands-on scrutiny in the field (smoothness, texture, longitudinal and transverse joint performance) by a select group of professionals along with quality assurance test results conducted by a third party. The highest ranking of the two measurements combined determines the winner of the category.

## First Place: Full Depth

US-183/US-270, Woodward Co., four-lane expansion between Woodward and Seiling. The Full Depth winner cost $\$ 12$ million.
The project, located in Northwestern Oklahoma, was constructed by ODOT's District 6 and Cummins Construction Company Inc. and designed by Smith Roberts Baldischwiler

## First Place: Rural Overlay

US-412, Woodward Co., milled and inlaid four lanes between Woodward and Mooreland. The Rural Overlay winner cost $\$ 5$ million.
This project, located in Northwestern Oklahoma, was designed and constructed by ODOT's District 6 and Cummins Construction Company Inc.

## First Place: Urban Overlay

SH-33/SH-3, Blaine Co., from one mile east of the US-270 junction extending east into Watonga. This Urban Overlay winner cost $\$ 10$ million.
The project, located in Western Oklahoma, was designed by ODOT's District 5 Clinton Residency and constructed by District 5 and Cummins Construction Company Inc.

## SUBJECT: Additions to the Industrial Access Road Program

## a) Commission District VIII - Creek County

The Creek County Board of Commissioners are requesting approval for an industrial access project for the Jones Memorial Airport. The airport is investing more than $\$ 1,400,000$ to construct a new hangar and fueling station that will create up to 10 new full-time jobs.

The proposed project begins at the intersection of State Highway 48 and West 241st Street South and extends west approximately 2.0 miles to South $385^{\text {th }}$ West Avenue, then south for approximately 1.0 mile , then east on West $251^{\text {st }}$ Street South for approximately 2.0 miles to State Highway 48. The County will be responsible for the initiation, construction and completion of all work associated with the project. The total cost of the project is approximately $\mathbf{\$ 1 , 4 0 0 , 0 0 0}$. The Creek Nation will contribute $\$ 650,000$ and the County will contribute $\$ 100,000$. The Department's participation in the project shall not exceed $\$ 650,000$.

## b) Commission District I - Muskogee County

The Muskogee City-County Port Authority is requesting approval for an industrial access project for the Griffin Industrial Park. Core Industries and YZY Capital are investing more than $\$ 1,200,000,000$ to construct a new data center and are creating more than 60 new full-time jobs.

The proposed project begins at Dal Tile Road and Smith Ferry Road and extends West on Smith Ferry Road approximately 0.5 miles to South $24^{\text {th }}$ Street West, then South on South $24^{\text {th }}$ Street West for approximately 0.5 miles. The Port Authority will be responsible for the initiation, construction and completion of all work associated with the project. The total cost of the project is approximately $\mathbf{\$ 2 , 7 0 0 , 0 0 0}$. The Department's participation in the project shall not exceed $\mathbf{\$ 1 , 6 0 0 , 0 0 0}$.

## c) Commission District I - Muskogee County

The Muskogee County Commissioners are requesting approval for an industrial access project near Oktaha, Oklahoma. YZY Capital is investing more than $\$ 80,000,000$ to construct a new data center and creating more than 40 new full-time jobs.

The proposed project begins on West $133^{\text {rd }}$ Street South at Oktaha Road and extends west for approximately 0.80 miles to South $104^{\text {th }}$ Street South, then turns north on South $104^{\text {th }}$ Street South and extends north for approximately 0.50 miles. The County will be responsible for the initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation shall not exceed $\mathbf{\$ 2 8 0 , 0 0 0}$.

In accordance with Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 730, Chapter 10, no work on access roads will proceed until the local government units have entered into a formal agreement with the Department to complete the project as stated and have agreed to maintain the access road upon completion.

## SUBJECT: Emergency Declaration for NBI 04076, Str. 0814 1711X, Bridge over Creek in Caddo County - District VII - Repair of Damaged Portion of Bridge Structure Project

Settlement of the bridge superstructure at pier 9 was due to a loss of support beneath the bearing at Span 9, Pier 9, beam 1. Temporary shim plates were installed as a stop gap measure to prevent further settlement and traffic is restricted to one lane; the East bound lane is closed. An emergency repair project must be initiated to reconstruct the South cantilever portion of pier 9 and install new bearing devices beneath Beam 1, Spans 9 and 10.

In accordance with Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 130 and the Oklahoma Administrative Code, Section 730:1-5-1(4), I declare that an emergency exists which impairs the safety of the traveling public and I authorize the Department to issue an emergency contract for repairing this pier including all associated traffic costs. The estimated cost is $\$ 250,000.00$
