## Subject: Settlement for Damages to State Property

a) On May 13th, 2020, Mr. Spencer was traveling on SH 75 in Tulsa County near W 61st St. Mr . Spencer lost control of his vehicle causing damage to a cable barrier. The cost to repair the cable barrier was $\$ 2,803.60$.

Mr. Spencer was an uninsured motorist. Mr. Spencer is offering ODOT in the amount of $\$ 2,523.24$. Acceptance of this settlement leaves a remaining balance of $\$ 280.36$, which is uncollectible. It is not cost-effective to pursue the remaining balance.
b) On June 17 ${ }^{\text {th }}$, 2020, Mr. Jackson was traveling on SH 10 in Delaware County near County Road EW 255. Mr. Jackson lost control of his vehicle causing damage to another vehicle and a guardrail. The cost to repair the guardrail was $\$ 707.50$.

Mr. Jackson was insured by Progressive Insurance Company with a policy limit of $\$ 25,000$. Total damages exceed the policy limit, and Progressive is offering ODOT a prorated distribution in the amount of $\$ 666.07$. Acceptance of this settlement leaves a remaining balance of $\$ 41.43$ which is uncollectible. It is not cost-effective to pursue the remaining balance.
c) On January 10th, 2022, Ms. Thrower was traveling South on I-44 WB in Oklahoma City near 59th Street. Ms. Thrower lost control of her vehicle causing damage to another vehicle and a cable barrier. The cost to repair the cable barrier was $\$ 1,017.50$.

Ms. Thrower was insured by Bristol West Insurance Company with a policy limit of $\$ 25,000$. Total damages exceed the policy limit, and Bristol West is offering ODOT a prorated distribution in the amount of $\$ 867.85$. Acceptance of this settlement leaves a remaining balance of $\$ 149.65$ which is uncollectible. It is not cost-effective to pursue the remaining balance.
d) On February 27th, 2021, Mr. Martin was traveling on South on I-35 in Noble County near Mile Marker 202. Mr. Martin fell asleep and lost control of his vehicle causing damage to another vehicle and a cable barrier. The cost to repair the cable barrier was $\$ 4,036.88$.

Mr. Martin was insured by Geico Insurance Company with a policy limit of 50,000. Total damages exceed the policy limit, and Geico is offering ODOT a prorated distribution in the amount of $\$ 1,500.00$. Acceptance of this settlement leaves a remaining balance of $\$ 2,536.88$ in damages which is uncollectible. It is not cost-effective to pursue the remaining balance.

Title 69, Section 1002 of the Oklahoma Statutes provides the Transportation Commission with the authority to settle claims that it may have against any person for damages to facilities belonging to the Department.

The Department recommends and requests acceptance of this settlement offer.
