## 71. Director's Report - Information Only - Chief Engineer, Brian Taylor Presenting on behalf of Executive Director, Tim Gatz

Chief Engineer, Brian Taylor began the Director's report by recognizing the response of the ODOT field crew with the inclement weather we had on the weekend of April $27^{\text {th }}$ and acknowledged that District VII has been continuously working the damage since the tornado occurrence. ODOT will continue to coordinate activities with local authorities and other agencies to provide resources to assist with cleanup as needed. Taylor commended the field districts for the work they have done and will continue to do for the communities.

Chief Taylor informed the Commission on the second annual Oklahoma Safe Summit, which had more than 300 attendees join the Department in discussion on safety challenges, solutions, and innovative
ideas to assist in keeping Oklahomans as safe as possible. ODOT looks forward to hosting the third annual Summit in 2025.

Chief Taylor advised the Commission on the Route 66 Bridgeport Bridge ribbon cutting on May $10^{\text {th }}$ which will be the first official celebration of the Route 66 Centennial. The bridge has been closed for construction since 2022. ODOT Director Tim Gatz was nominated by Governor Stitt and appointed by President Joe Biden to chair the Route 66 Centennial.

Chief Taylor updated the Commission on several projects, starting with the seven mile, resurface and addition of shoulders in District I, Adair County on US-59. The project is between SH-51 and the Barren Fork Creek near Stilwell on a rural two-lane highway and is expected to start November 2024 and be completed late 2025.

The second project update is in District II, in McCurtain County, north of SH-87 junction northwest toward Idabel. It is estimated to begin late fall 2024 and be completed in 2025.

Chief Taylor advised the Commission and the traveling public on the bridge rehabilitation project on I-235 and I-40 and to expect traffic delays during peak hours.

Chief Taylor concluded the Director's report by acknowledging motorcycle safety and encouraged all motorists to follow standard safety protocol, especially around motorcycles. Taylor added the top three contributing factors to fatalities, unsafe speed, making improper movements or changes and following too closely, motorcycle safety is everyone's safety.

SUBJECT: Addition to the Industrial Access Road Program

## LOCATION: District III - Lincoln County

a) The Lincoln County Commissioners are requesting approval for additional funding for a previously approved industrial access project. The Lincoln County Commissioners requested \$470,000 for a project for National American Insurance Company (NAICO), who was expanding and adding 300 new jobs. The project begins on NS3520 at EW900 and extends south approximately 2.0 miles. This project was approved at the June 2021 Commission meeting. Inflation and rising construction costs have increased the dollar amount needed to fund and fully complete this project.

The total increase for this project is $\$ 630,000$ for a total not to exceed amount of $\mathbf{\$ 1 , 1 0 0 , 0 0 0 . 0 0}$.

In accordance with Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 730, Chapter 10, no work on access roads will proceed until the local government units have entered into a formal agreement with the Department to complete the project as stated and have agreed to adequately maintain the access road upon completion.

LOCATION: Multiple Districts - Statewide

## a) District I-Haskell County

The Haskell County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Red Hill Park on Robert S. Kerr Lake.

The project begins at the intersection of NCR 4540 and ECR 1180 and extends north on NCR 4540 for 3.0 miles to ECR 1150, then extends west on ECR 1150 for 1 mile to NCR 4530 . Project will be 4.0 miles total, ending at Red Hill Park. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 600,000.00$.
b) District I-Sequoyah County

The Sequoyah County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for the Robert S. Kerr Reservoir. Kerr Reservoir boasts 250 miles of shoreline and connects with 10,000 acres managed by the Army Corps of Engineers. Amenities include camping, boating, hiking and camping.

The proposed project begins at the intersection of E1140 Rd and US-59, then extends west approximately 2.5 miles to where D1135 Rd splits from E1140 Rd, then extends northwesterly for approximately 1.0 miles, to the shared yard between the U.S. Coastguard and the Army Corps of Engineers. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 258,000.00$.
c) District II - Bryan County

The Bryan County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Lake Texoma, near the Denison Dam.

The project begins at the intersection of SH-91 and Red River City Road and extends south for approximately 2.5 miles to property owned by the Army Corps of Engineers, near the Texas state line. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 520,000.00$.

## d) District II - McCurtain County

The McCurtain County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Pine Creek Lake. Pine Creek Lake is located on SH-3 25 miles east of Broken Bow and 30 miles west of Antlers. Amenities include camping, fishing and swimming.

The project begins at the intersection of Old Highway 98 and E2040 Rd and extends west 1.99 miles, ending at Pine Creek Road. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed \$592,000.00.

## e) District III - Hughes County

The Hughes County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Dustin Lake. Dustin Lake is a spring-fed municipal reservoir with a capacity of 3.2 million gallons.

The project begins at the intersection of NS393 and SH-9 and extends north approximately 0.75 miles to EW 120 Rd , then extends east on EW 120 Rd approximately 0.5 miles to the lake entrance. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ \mathbf{1 8 0 , 0 0 0 . 0 0}$.

## f) District III - McClain County

The McClain County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Maysville Lake. Also known as Wiley Post Memorial Lake, Maysville Lake has 5.6 miles of shoreline and offers boating and fishing.

The project begins at the intersection of $120^{\text {th }}$ Street and Horse Avenue and extends south for 1.0 miles to $110^{\text {th }}$ Street. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\mathbf{\$ 1 9 0 , 0 0 0 . 0 0}$.

## g) District IV - Logan County

The Logan County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Lake Langston. Lake Langston is located 1.5 miles south of $\mathrm{SH}-33$ and boasts 8.8 miles of shoreline. Amenities include boating and picnicking.

The project begins at the intersection of Choctaw Road and Old Highway 33 and extends south on Choctaw Rd for 2.0 miles, ending at ECR 76. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ \mathbf{6 5 0 , 0 0 0 . 0 0}$.

## h) District IV - Payne County

The Payne County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Lone Chimney Lake. Lone Chimney Lake is located just east of Glencoe, north of the Cimarron Turnpike and west of $\mathrm{SH}-18$. Amenities include boating and fishing.

Project begins at the intersection of Lone Chimney and Mt Vernon Rd and extends north to Noble Rd, then west on Noble Rd to Lone Chimney entrance. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 781,000.00$.

## i) District V - Roger Mills

The Roger Mills County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Spring Creek Lake. Spring Creek Lake is located 14 miles north of the city of Cheyenne, inside the Black Kettle National Grassland. Amenities include boating and fishing.

This project begins at the intersection of NS1760 and EW860, and extends east on EW860 for 2.0 miles to NS1780. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 84,000.00$.

## j) District VII - Caddo County

The Caddo County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Fort Cobb Lake. Located within Fort Cobb State Park, Fort Cobb Lake offers 4,000 surface acres for swimming, fishing and water sports.

The project begins at the intersection of E 1250 Rd and N 2540 Rd and extends south 1.0 mile to E 1260 Rd, then extends east 1.0 mile to N 2550 then South 0.53 Miles to Copperhead Rd. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 366,000.00$.

## k) District VII - Stephens County

The Stephens County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Waurika Lake. Located ten miles north of Waurika between SH-5 and SH-53, Waurika Lake offers camping, boating and fishing.

The project begins at the intersection of E1860 Rd and N2740 Rd and extends east for 2.0 miles, to NW2760. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ 184,000.00$.

## I) District VIII - Craig County

The Craig County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Vinita Lake. Opened in 2017, Vinita Lake sits approximately 2.0 miles north of the Will Rogers Turnpike. Vinita Lake offers fishing and "no wake" boating.

The project begins at the intersection of E 260 Rd and S 4420 Rd, just north of 1-44/Will Rogers Turnpike, then extends north on S4420 Rd for approx. 2.0 miles to the turnoff for Vinita Lake Park, them extends east for approx. 0.5 miles, ending at the park area. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ \mathbf{3 0 0 , 0 0 0} \mathbf{0 0}$.

## m) District VIII - Creek County

The Creek County Commissioners are requesting approval for a lake access project for Stroud Lake. Located just over the Creek County line, Stroud Lake offers 600 surface acres with thirteen miles of shoreline. Amenities include swimming, boating and horseback riding trails.

The project begins at the Lincoln/Creek county line on E840 Rd and extends north, then east, then north again for 1.0 miles, ending at the parking area next to the lake. The county will be responsible for initiation, construction, and completion of all work associated with the project. The Department's participation cost shall not exceed $\$ \mathbf{2 5 5 , 0 0 0} \mathbf{0 0}$.

In accordance with Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 730, Chapter 10, no work on access roads will proceed until the local government units have entered into a formal agreement with the Department to complete the project as stated and have agreed to adequately maintain the access road upon completion.

## SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Work Program

LOCATION: Statewide

The Department is required to submit a Budget Work Program to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in June of each year, which will provide budget authority for the upcoming fiscal year. In keeping with that process, the Department is submitting for Commission approval the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Work Program. An attachment is provided for Commission review, which indicates expenditures by category along with the anticipated revenue.

General appropriations Senate Bill (SB) 1125 provided revenue to the Highway Program. The State Transportation Fund, which includes Motor Fuel Tax revenue allocated by statute and appropriated to the State Transportation Fund for the fiscal year 2025, is estimated to be $\$ 216,239,461.00$, an increase of $\$ 4,837,893.00$ or $2.2 \%$ from 2024. The Rebuilding Oklahoma Access and Driver Safety (ROADS) Fund allocated by statute and appropriated is a combination of Motor Fuel Tax, Motor Vehicle Collections, and Income Tax totaling \$590,000,000.00 for fiscal year 2025, unchanged from 2024. In addition, SB 1125 appropriated $\$ 30,104,250.00$ from the state's General Revenue Fund as well as $\$ 200,000,000.00$ to the Rural Economic Transportation Reliability and Optimization (RETRO) Fund for fiscal year 2025. For the balance of the highway portion of the total budget, funding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will be used as the primary source of revenue.

The County portion of the total budget is related primarily to the County Improvement for Roads and Bridges (CIRB) program, funded with an annual amount of \$101,250,000.00 from Motor Vehicle Collections revenue, an increase of $\$ 3,750,000.00$ or $3.6 \%$.

It is anticipated that budget revisions will be necessary during the year. Those revisions will be submitted to the Commission for review and approval at the appropriate time.

The Department requests and recommends approval of this budget totaling $\$ 2,549,262,519.00$.
