This request is for DBE firms that are interested in enhancing their marketing abilities. Website services must be offered from hosting sites that can be verified. In order to participate, DBE firms are required to submit their request at least two months before service. Services completed prior to a request or approval will not be reimbursed. Incomplete requests will not be approved. No training will be paid unless prior approval is obtained from the DBE Supportive Services Coordinator. Qualifying applications will be approved on a first-come, first-serve basis, as funds are available.
