Public Involvement

ODOT began preliminary engineering on the US-259 corridor while consulting with an advisory group made up of representatives from the unincorporated community, the State Representative, State Senator, Choctaw Nation, McCurtain County, Oklahoma Department of Tourism and the City of Broken Bow.

ODOT has conducted 2 public involvement sessions, one on October 27, 2022 and one May 16, 2023 in addition to continued coordination with the Hochatown Board of Trustees and other stakeholders.

Resolutions

The Town of Hochatown approved two resolutions regarding their support for the highway improvements on US-259.

In June 2023, the town approved a resolution for support of the improvements from SH-259A South to SH-259A North (Resolution attached).

WHEREAS, the Town of Hochatown agrees that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation should expand a portion of US-259, from the existing two-lane highway, to a four-lane highway with a center turn lane, beginning near the intersection of SH-259a (South) and extending north to near the intersection of SH-259a (North); and,

In September 2023, the Town of Hochatown approved another resolution for support of the improvements from SH-259a South through Golf Course Road (Resolution Attached)

WHEREAS, the Town of Hochatown agrees that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation should expand a portion of US-259, from the existing two-lane highway, to a four-lane highway with a center turn lane, beginning near the intersection of SH-259a(South) and extending north to Golf Course Rd, encompassing the entire six-mile project.

Preferred Alternative

In November 2023, ODOT sent out a project update which clarified that the preferred alternative for the project was the 5-lane section throughout the entire project extent. This was sent out in a postcard.

Project Extents

The project scheduled for letting this year will begin at SH-259a South and extend north 2 miles to SH-259a North. The Choctaw Nation is constructing a portion of US-259 approximately 0.5 miles south of SH-259a North and extending to the intersection. The Choctaw Nation's project will construct approximately half of the future needed typical section after coordinating the needs with ODOT.



The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) has selected a 5-lane configuration instead of a 3-lane configuration for the proposed US-259 project in Hochatown. ODOT selected the 5-lane configuration for all three project segments based on the following three factors: 1) the Design Engineer recommended a 5-lane configuration for safety and traffic flow purposes, 2) the majority of the general public was in favor of the 5-lane versus the 3-lane configuration, and 3) the Town of Hochatown passed a resolution recommending the 5-lane configuration for all three segments of the project. ODOT is proceeding into detailed design, and construction is scheduled to begin at the southernmost segment in 2024.
